b. Part II - Narrative Summary

(1) Air Operations

(a) During this reporting period VM CJ-1 (-) EF-10B aircraft conducted electronic countermeasures against fire control radars in the Vinh, Than Hoa, Thai Binh and Hai Phong areas in North Viet Nam in support of forty-seven 2nd Air Division and thirty-two 7th Fleet "Rolling Thunder" strikes.

(b) In addition to the above missions, twelve tactical ELINT missions in North Viet Nam were conducted in support of 2nd Air Division for the collection and location of fire control and SA-2 missile associated radar emissions.

(c) VM CJ-1 (-) RF-8A aircraft flew sixteen in-country Photo Reconnaissance missions during the reporting period in support of III MAF, photographing areas in the vicinity of Danang, Hue and Chu Lai.
