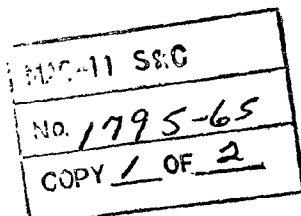

1. In accordance with reference (a), subject report is submitted.
2. During this reporting period VM CJ-1 (-) EF-10B aircraft conducted electronic countermeasures against fire control and SA-2 missile radars in the Vinh, Than Hoa and Hai Phong areas in North Viet Nam in support of forty-six 2nd Air Division and two 7th Fleet "Rolling Thunder" and "Iron Hand" strikes and armed recce missions.
3. In addition to the above missions, twenty-one "Iron Hand" ELINT missions in North Viet Nam were conducted in support of 2nd Air Division for the location and collection of SA-2 missile and fire control radar emissions.
4. VM CJ-1 (-) RF-8A aircraft flew thirty-six in-country photographic reconnaissance missions during the reporting period in support of III MAF, photographing areas in the vicinity of Danang, Hue and Chu Lai.
5. VM CJ-1 Detachment Alpha, embarked aboard the U.S.S. Bon Homme Richard (CVA-31), flew 25 photographic reconnaissance sorties for 55.0 hours in support of 7th Fleet "Barrel Roll", "Rolling Thunder" and "Iron Hand" missions in Laos and North Viet Nam.
6. A breakdown of sorties and hours by type mission for both the EF-10B and RF-8A aircraft is contained in enclosure (2).

- d. Average Strength - 36 Officers, 142 Enlisted

PART II - Significant Events

- a. Air Operations - See enclosure (2)
- b. Personnel - Advance Cadre of 16 officers and 28 enlisted arrived on 7 October
- c. Administration - Air Medals awarded to 17 officers
- d. Special Operations - Emphasis was placed upon providing warning of SA-2 missile threats to photo reconnaissance and armed reconnaissance aircraft operating within suspected or known SAM envelopes.
- e. Combat Readiness - Combat readiness of the squadron's photo capability has improved considerably from the last reporting period due to the receipt of AOCF items for the RF-8A. Combat readiness in the EF-10B aircraft remains high.
