(U) 1. In accordance with reference (a), subject report is submitted.

(S) 2. During this reporting period VMCJ-1 EF-10B aircraft conducted electronic countermeasures against AAA and SA-2 fire control radars in North Viet Nam. Fifty-eight (58) sorties were flown in support of 7th Air Force and seventy (70) in support of 7th Fleet.

(S) 3. In addition to the above missions, nine (9) "Iron Hand" ELINT sorties in North Viet Nam were conducted for the 7th Air Force and 7th Fleet, for the location and collection of AAA and SA-2 fire control radar emissions.

(U) 4. VMCJ-1 RF-8A aircraft flew one hundred and forty eight (148) in-country photographic reconnaissance missions in support of III MAF. This figure represents more sorties in support of the III MAF than any previous month.
