3. (U) Important Visitors. The visitors listed below were shown a static display of VMCJ-1 aircraft and were given a short brief by the Commanding Officer.

a. The Honorable John F. CHAFEE, Secretary of the Navy, and the Honorable Charles A. BOWSER, Assistant Secretary of the Navy for Financial Management, visited the Squadron on 25 May.

b. Brigadier General Jaskika, Assistant Division Commander, 1st Marine Division visited the Squadron on 28 May.

PART II. (S) Narrative Summary of Significant Highlights

1. (S) On 17 May, VMCJ-1 held a Change of Command Ceremony and Lieutenant Colonel B. R. HALL was relieved by Lieutenant Colonel P. P. MARQUES Jr. VMCJ-1 continued to provide ECM support for Navy and Marine Corps Blue Tree Photo Reconnaissance Missions. Tactics employed by the Squadron in support of the DMZ remained the same, however a new "Feet Dry" track has been instituted which includes an extended leg from the western IP of the old track, 1641N 10638E, to a Northern IP, 1710N 10555E. The "Feet Dry" track now runs from 1641N 10720E to 1641N 10638E to 1710N 10555E, the 305°/125° leg in Laos paralleling North Vietnam at an average distance of 20 NM and the 270°/090° leg remaining as previously fraged.

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Carrying of the Shrike missile has temporarily been discontinued so that two additional ALQ-76 pods could be added to the three already carried by two of the Squadron's EA-6A aircraft. These have been utilized to support 7th Air Force "Bumpy Action" operations protecting drones flown over North Vietnam. Favorable weather conditions existing throughout the month of May accounted for our increase in photographic reconnaissance coverage over the previous month. Our target completion rate for May was over 100% for optical photographic missions. IR coverage increased in the Republic of Vietnam as did IR coverage in Laos where we continued to record intense enemy activity. Required photo coverage of the DMZ area was decreased by 7th Air Force during May but our fragged coverage continued to result in significant intelligence data from this vital area.

1. In accordance with references (a) through (e) the following report is submitted.

A. Maintenance Situation

The Maintenance Situation during this reporting period was satisfactory as witnessed by the achievement of 100% utilization in each of the three types of aircraft flown by the squadron. A lack of supervisory personnel exists which hampers mission accomplishment. A total of 461.0 awaiting maintenance hours were documented during this period. A NORM rate of 17.2% above the average set in reference (e) was obtained.
