PART II. (S) Narrative Summary of Significant Highlights.

Tactics for ECM support of Navy and Marine Corps Blue Tree Photo Reconnaissance missions remained the same as last month. Both the feet dry track for DMZ support and the PECM track remained the same. The PECM track has been flown when Blue Tree Reconnaissance missions are cancelled or when fragged. At times, thunderstorm buildup over Laos has resulted in flying the Chartreuse track rather than the Laos track. The DMZ operations as a whole have not changed since the last report, with the fragged times remaining 1930-2300H. Several times during the month, aircraft flying in the DMZ area have requested VMJ-1 support, and the standby crews have been successfully utilized.

The configuration and tactics for Bumpy Action remained the same for the month of July with continued success.

The number of emitters jammed during July decreased approximately 19% whereas the number of emitters detected passively increased by 18%. This can possibly be accredited to the greater number of passive missions being flown. Also, a "P" band antenna has been installed in some of the EF-10B aircraft. On flights of two (2) EF-10B's, one aircraft searches the low frequency while the other limits search to the higher frequencies. This has increased the number of signals significantly.

Weather conditions conducive to useful optical and infrared reconnaissance data gathering, continued to exist in the I Corps area throughout the month of July. Unfortunately, Aircraft availability presented unforeseen problems which led to a decrease in productivity compared to the previous month. Actual target coverage amounted to 80% of the targets assigned.

IR output in South Vietnam and Laos and the optical missions flown in the vital DMZ area continued to result in significant military intelligence data.

c. On 2 July 1969, RF-4B, Buno 153111, was placed in an unscheduled maintenance status after repairs had been completed by the STRAAD team Danang to damage caused by the accidental firing of the rear ejection seat on 2 June 1969.

d. On 2 July 1969, EA-6A, Buno 147865, was inducted into the Rework process at the Naval Air Rework Facility, Norfolk, Virginia. At the time of its induction, the estimated completion date was given as 18 September 1969.

e. On 3 July 1969, RF-4B, Buno 153110, returned from NAS Cubi Point in the Philippines after incorporation of AFC 331, installation of the KY-28.

f. On 22 July 1969, EA-6A's, Bunos 156982 and 156984, arrived at Danang for service. This brought to eight the number of EA-6A aircraft assigned to J-1 and to six the number actually on hand. Bunos 147865 and 151596, both in the Rework process at NARF NORVA, remain in VMJ-1 reporting custody.

g. On 23 July 1969, EF-10B, Buno 127060 was transferred to Naval Air Systems Command, Fleet Service custody upon arrival at continental dockside, United States. This aircraft, damaged during a wheels up landing on 28 March 1969, was subsequently struck from the Naval Inventory on 24 July 1969.

1. In accordance with references (a) through (e), the following report is submitted:

A. Maintenance Situation:

The Maintenance Situation during this period was satisfactory. A lack of supervisory personnel and ground support equipment (MC 10, Garwood) exists which hampers mission accomplishment. The AOCF and AMFE rate remained high, however no supply assist is required at this time. During this period the Squadron flew 484 sorties for 797.1 hours. This is 265.9 hours less than the scheduled time, mainly due to the high MORS rate and unscheduled maintenance. Two new EA6A's were received during this period.

(c) Comments on scope and impact of causative factors when MORS and NORM standards exceeded:

1. EF-10B

Of the 8 EF-10B's on hand during this period, a MORS rate of 16.5% above the average set in reference (c) was obtained. This was due to the 84 AOCF's that were recorded during this period. A NORM rate of 9% above the average set in reference (c) was obtained. This was due mainly to lack of supervisory personnel in 6200 and 6300 field, lack of qualified personnel to work on this type aircraft and the high awaiting maintenance hours reported 86.3 during this period.

2. EA-6A

Of the 4.5 EA-6A's on hand during this period, a MORS rate of 22.5% above the average set in reference (c) was obtained. This was due to the 58 AOCF's that were recorded during this period. A NORM rate of 9.1% above the average set in reference (c) was obtained. This was due mainly to the lack of qualified personnel in this type aircraft, lack of supervisory personnel in the 6200 and 6300 field and the receipt of the two new EA-6A that required acceptance inspection, inventory and extensive work on the systems.

3. RF-4B

Of the 9 RF-4B's on hand during this period, a MORS rate of 17.2% above the average set in reference (c) was obtained. This was due to the 142 AOCF's that were recorded during this period. A NORM rate of 22% above the average set in reference (c) was obtained. This was due mainly to the high unscheduled maintenance rate, lack of supervisory personnel in the 6200 and 6300 field and lack of qualified personnel to work on this type aircraft.
