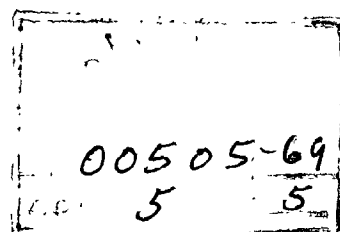

3. (U) Important Visitors

a. On 7 August, General Leonard F. CHAPMAN, Commandant of the Marine Corps received a TSQ-90 brief and saw the TSQ-82 Image Interpretation Module. General CHAPMAN was accompanied by Lieutenant General NICKERSON, CG, III MAF, Major General THRASH, CG, 1st MAW, and Brigadier General DOOLEY, Chief of Staff, III MAF.

b. On 20 August, the Honorable John W. WARNER, Under Secretary of the Navy visited the squadron and received a short brief by the Commanding Officer and a static display of the squadron's aircraft.

c. Colonel WILCOX, 1st MAR DIV G-2, also visited the squadron on 20 August and was given a brief by the Commanding Officer on squadron aircraft and the TSQ-90.

d. On 21 August, Lieutenant Colonel YUNOT, Director of Data Systems, III MAF, and ten other officers received a brief on the TSQ-90.

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d. Colonel J. E. BRUCE, Commanding Officer, MAG-16, Colonel E. J. ARTNAK, Wing Controller 1st MAW, Lieutenant Colonel E. S. MURPHY, Assistant Chief of Staff, G-3 1st MAW, and Lieutenant Colonel W. K. PARCELL, Operations Officer G-3 1st MAW were given an operational brief and a TSQ-90 brief on 25 August.

PART II. (S) Narrative Summary of Significant Highlights

Tactics for ECM support of Navy and Marine Corps Blue Tree Photo Reconnaissance remain essentially the same as last month. Greater emphasis has been placed on more careful scrutiny of emitters and more care taken to jam only the threat emitters. Both the feet dry track and the feet wet track for DMZ support remain the same. The ESM tracks have been varied whenever possible to better position the aircraft for coverage of the area where light signal activity is expected. Greater emphasis has been placed on ESM coverage of Laos, with several special missions being flown in support of MAG-11 aircraft. The DMZ operations as a whole have not changed since the last report with the fragged times remaining 1930-2300H.

The configuration and tactics for Bumpy Action remain the same as in previous months with continued success.

The number of emitters jammed during August decreased approximately 22% while the number of emitters detected passively increased 18% over last month. These changes can generally be accredited to the greater emphasis being placed on selective jamming and more passive work. In order to improve the quality of ELINT Data reported, efforts are being made to analyze all mission tapes prior to submitting OPREPS.

The weather in Northern I Corps and Laos began to deterriate this month. This hindered the gathering of useful optical and infrared reconnaissance data. Aircraft availability and camera malfunctions also contributed to the decrease in photo productivity for the month of August. Actual target coverage was 69% of the targets fragged.

The squadron was fragged for six priority one missions during the month with 100% completion on these.
