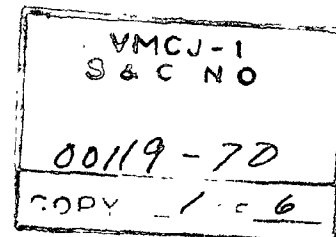

PART II (S) - Narrative Summary of Significant Highlights

VMCJ-1 compiled an outstanding operational record in the month of February despite the fact that the squadron is operating significantly under its manning level. The manning level for Naval Aviators is 26, and 24 for Naval Flight Officers. VMCJ-1 is operating with 21 and 16 respectively. Nine Air Medals were awarded to our flight crews during the month.

During February several operational changes were made affecting VMCJ-1 Electronic Warfare. These included mission assignments, aircraft configurations, and code name changes. Also, there was a marked increase in active missions. In addition, improved results were obtained on the passive missions.

On 12 February, the VMCJ-1 tradition of the DMZ patrol came to an end. On that night the last scheduled DMZ/Stool Tigor mission was flown by 1/Lt. M. C. LINDEN and 1/LT A. A. CARTER. In its place VMCJ-1 maintains a one-half hour alert with a one-hour alert backup. Since no more DMZ missions are being flown, a greater number of ESM missions are being flown during the day, which explains in part the increase for the number of emitters intercepted. Another reason for the increase is that a much greater emphasis has been put on ESM by the EW section.

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There was a large increase in active missions. Navy support increased from 9 to 33 sorties. This increase can generally be attributed to the good weather for the month. The code name of "Bumpy Action" was changed to "Buffalo Hunter", and the EA-6A supported 19 Air Force drones. Staying with the tactic of using 2 EA-6A's for each mission, 35 sorties were flown in support of the 19 drone launches. One change in Buffalo Hunter tactics has been the addition of one more ALQ-76 per airplane. This change gives each EA-6A a total of 9 "S" band and 3 "L" band transmitters.

There was a 70% increase in the number of emitters jammed, and a 31% increase in the number of emitters intercepted, but not jammed. The increase in jamming was due to the large increase in active missions flown.

The productivity of the Photo missions increased considerably due to the generally favorable weather experienced over most of the target areas. Of the 263 missions scheduled, 127 were flown, 85 were cancelled due to poor weather and 37 for aircraft availability. Of the 463 targets attempted a new high of 345 were completed. In addition, 10 bonus targets were completed. Target completion rate climbed to 76.7% with a high target per sortie rate of 2.80. Of the 118 targets not completed, 31 were lost for weather, 37 for missed targets, and 23 for camera malfunction.

The photo lab printed 120,018 negatives, completed 363 job orders, and processed 147,700 feet of film. 50,886 gallons of water were used for 946 machine hours of work.

During the month, Pigment-52 which is being flown in support of H&MS-11 "Playboy" VR program, was changed from daily to bi-daily. Pigment-50 into North Vietnam was reactivated with the bettering weather.

Additionally 18 IR missions were flown covering 1,433 nautical miles. No SIR was flown with no targets requested.

Overall, February was the best photo month for VMCJ-1 since September 1969. No hits were taken and the completion rate was the highest on record.

VMCJ-1 compiled a perfect safety record for the month of February. There were no incidents or accidents during the month. Additional effort was aimed towards improvement and upgrading the enlisted men's living conditions. In an attempt to maintain high morale, existing water heaters were repaired and their capacity improved. Also, a revitalized attack has been launched for improvement of the environmental conditions in the enlisted living area.
