NARRATIVE SUMMARY

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GENERAL.

On 28 April, VMO-2 (-) was created and designated as part of the 9th Marine Expeditionary Brigade. 11 Naval Aviators, 3 Ground Officers, and 69 Enlisted embarked on the USS Princeton and C-130 aircraft for Da Nang. 10 Officers and 61 Enlisted remained at Futema as VMO-2(REAR). During May the sub unit which had been maintained at Atsugi was relocated at Futema.

The advance party of 2 Officers and 39 Enlisted arrived Danang at the end of April to establish camp, a task undertaken in an intense sandstorm and 113-degree temperature which caused two minor heat casualties. HMM-162 offered to share its camp facilities and provided assistance in obtaining many essential items which the advance party had been unable to bring with it in mounting out rapidly by air.

At 0930 on 3 May, 12 Officers and 30 Enlisted flew ashore from LPH-5, the USS Princeton, with 3 O-1B and 6 UH-1E(ARMED) aircraft. Flight operations were begun on 4 May, and shortly thereafter the UH-1E flew their first combat mission.

On 8 May, operational control of the Squadron passed from the 9th MEB to the Third Amphibious Force, under the command of Maj Gen COLLINS. On 13 May, 3 O-1B aircraft were joined from HMM-163, giving the squadron six of each aircraft to perform its dual mission of observation and armed escort.

Commitments were heavy throughout the month, and personnel of the Squadron gained much practical experience, particularly with the armed UH-1E. An intense training program was effected for those personnel assigned as gunners, and practice runs were made on the Nui Son Ga range. Pilots and crewmen soon had numerous opportunities to fire the aircraft's ordnance on actual missions, and the performance of the UH-1E in its armed escort role became highly effective. By the end of the month 22 members of the squadron had become qualified gunners.

A major operation in which the Squadron was involved was the landing of a Marine RLt at Chu Lai, south of DaNang. From 6 May until 20 May, 2 UH-1E operated from an LPH off the coast and other UH-1E and O-1B aircraft operated from DaNang on various missions in support of the operations.

UH-1E aircraft were hit by enemy ground fire on 3 occasions during the month. 2 hits were taken in each instance, but no casualties were sustained and the aircraft were able to continue with their missions. The first hits were received by a UH-1E performing an armed escort during the Chu Lai operation. The aircraft was able to neutralize the hostile fire by strafing the village from which it came. In the second instance, a UH-1E was providing an armed escort during a helicopter troop lift near DaNang. The aircraft returned fire on the enemy, who were located near the landing zone, and also directed an air strike by F4B's on the position. Finally, during a large helicopter troop lift to an area south of DaNang, an escort UH-1E was making strafing runs on a hostile village across the river from the landing zone when it was hit. The aircraft continued to fire on the village and alerted other UH-1E from the Squadron to do the same.

The Squadron was privileged on several occasions during the month to fly senior Officers of the Marine Corps in the UH-1E. Distinguished passengers included LtGen V. H. KRULAK, CG FMFPAC. Flight Time in the UH-1E was logged by MajGen P. J. FONTANA, CG 1stMAW, BGen M. E. CARL, AND BGen K. B. McCUTCHEON.

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ADMINISTRATION.

At the beginning of operations in Viet Nam, Squadron strength was 11 Naval Aviators, 3 Ground Officers, and 69 Enlisted. On 13 May, 2 Naval Aviators and 4 Enlisted were joined from HMM-163 and 6 Enlisted Ordnance personnel were joined from MABS-16. The total strength for VMO-2(-) at the the end of May was 14 Naval Aviators, 3 Ground Officers, and 80 Enlisted.

OPERATIONS. See enclosure (3).

LOGISTICS.

Maintaining adequate supplies during the first part of the month was difficult, as transportation available for Squadron equipment from Futema was limited. However, no insurmountable logistics problems were encountered, and the Squadron was able to keep all equipment operational. Cooperation by other organizations in temporarily meeting shortcomings were appreciated, particularly the loan of a filter conversion kit from VMFA-531 and the use of the Army's 7th Aviation Platoon refueling facilities until the Squadron's refueler could be made operational. By the end of the month, initial difficulties had been largely overcome, and the supply system was functioning adequately.

In traveling 5530 Miles, the Squadron's motor vehicles consumed 365 gallons of diesel fuel and 345 gallons of gasoline, plus 50 quarts of oil. In addition, the electricity generator burned 765 gallons of gasoline and 44 quarts of oil, in 385 hours of operation. Electricity was generated for the other hours of the month by HMM-162 and HMM-163, with whom the Squadron had pooled generators. The heavy consumption of oil was due to the excessive dust conditions. No major repairs of motor transport equipment were necessitated during the month.

Fuel consumed by aircraft amounted to 16,770 gallons of JP-4 and 5,010 gallons of 115-145. Ammunition expenditure for the month was 39,418 rounds of 7.62 mm machine gun ammunition, 625 2.75 in rockets, and 173 smoke grenades.

AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE.

Major repairs to the UH-1E involved the replacement of one main rotor blade, one tail rotor blade, and one bell crank, all of which had been damaged by enemy fire. One aircraft was hit once by ground fire and another was hit twice. Otherwise no major repairs were necessitated. No O-1B parts needed to be replaced during the month of May.

Average availability for the month was 84.6% for the UH-1E and 95.3% for the O-1B..
