## NARRATIVE SUMMARY.

GENERAL. Commitments remained heavy during the month as the Squadron continued operations as part of the Third Marine Amphibious Force. The O-1B aircraft made daily reconnaissance flights of Marine TAOR'S at Chu Lai, DaNang, and Hue Phu Bai, and were utilized extensively as TAC(A) for aircraft of VMFA-513, VMA-311, and VMA-225. The UH-1E(armed) continued to perform well, being used in escort missions and in close air support of Marine infantry units. Much combat experience was gained by the Squadron's gunners, of which there were 12 qualified during June.

On 2 June, an O-1B was lost when it crashed and burned north of DaNang. The accident occurred near dusk as the aircraft was returning through Hai Van Pass from the evening perimeter patrol. The pilot, 1stLt Richard E. HEISTER, was killed, as was his aerial observer, Capt Werner E. LUTZ of the Third Marine Division. On 19 June, two O-1B aircraft were brought by air from MCAF Futema, giving the Squadron a total of seven O-1B and six UH-1E.

Two aircraft were hit by enemy ground fire during the month. On 26 June, a UH-1E flying armed escort for a helilift by HMM-365 was fired on from a village northwest of Chu Lai and received three hits. The first round entered the nose compartment and smashed the clock and wire bundles in the instrument panel. The pilot received approximately fifty pieces of wire fragments in his right leg, but was able to continue the mission. The second round entered the midsection underneath, and lodged in an ammunition can, slightly injuring the gunner, who received some small metal fragments in his right leg. The third round grazed the masthead. The aircraft neutralized the fire by attacking the village with rockets. Both of the wounded in this incident received the Purple Heart. Three days later, on 29 June, a UH-1E flying an armed reconnaissance mission in support of an operation south of Chu Lai received moderate small arms fire from a village and took one hit, the bullet passing through the rotor blade. Both UH-1E aircraft participating in this reconnaissance flight then attacked the village with rockets and machineguns, destroying twenty buildings.

The Squadron was privileged to fly several distinguished passengers during the month, including Secretary of the Navy Paul H. NITZE and Congressmen William G. BRAY, Charles E. CHAMBERLAIN, Richard H. ICHORD and Otis G. PIKE. Senior military officers flown included RAdm REEDY, USN; MajGen ROSSER, USA; MAJGEN L. W. WALT, CG III MAF; BGen K. B. McCUTCHEON, CG 1st MAW; BGen J. F. KARCH; and BGen C. A. YOUNGDALE.

ADMINISTRATION. Squadron strength at the beginning of June stood at 25 Naval Aviators, 5 Ground Officers, 142 Enlisted, and 4 attached Aerial Observers. Of these personnel, 14 Naval Aviators, 3 Ground Officers, 2 Aerial Observers, and 80 Enlisted comprised the Squadron Minus at Da Nang. During June there was a net gain of 3 Enlisted personnel, an additional Aerial Observer was attached, and one Naval Aviator was lost. At the end of the month, the Squadron Minus consisted of 13 Naval Aviators, 3 Ground Officers, 4 Aerial Observers, and 85 Enlisted, with 11 Naval Aviators, 2 Ground Officers, 1 Aerial Observer, and 60 Enlisted remaining at Futema.

LOGISTICS. Problems of supply continued to exist during July, due to lack of sufficient transportation from Futema, but the system functioned adequately and operational ability was not impaired. In traveling 6,356 miles, the Squadron's vehicles consumed 763 gallons of gasoline and diesel fuel, Major repairs were performed on one transmission-transfer case, one generator, and two starters and solenoids, but no vehicles required deadlining. Ordnance expended during the month amounted to 795 2.75" rockets, 82 grenades, and 11,574 rounds of 7.62mm ammunition.

AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE. Average aircraft availability for the month was 79.8% for the UH-1E and 61.9% for the O-1B. Fuel consumption was 4,116 gallons of 115/145 aviation gasoline and 23,558 gallons of JP-4 fuel.

Battle damage and heavy operational commitments necessitated several major repairs to Squadron aircraft. Among major parts replaced were two O-470-HA engines, fifty splice conductors for wire bundles, one blade assembly main rotor, one tail rotor, and a tube assembly, a tach gas producer, and an oil pressure indicator.
