PART II: NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. During the month of October, VMO-2 was heavily committed to "Operation Prairie," being conducted in Quang Tri Province, just south of the DMZ by a multi-battalion force of U.S. Marines and South Vietnamese forces. Our operations in the Danang TAOR were limited to providing the armed escort for the MAG-16 med-evac. mission and our daily commitment of two aircraft to the III MAF. Crews averaged three to five days at Dong Ha in support of "Prairie" and found the relief rotation back to Marble Mountain a welcome break. While engaged up north, the Squadron maintained an average of seven aircraft on a 24 hour alert for reconnaissance team insert and extraction missions, our requirement of three planes for command and control liaison for the Commanding Officers of the 3rd and 4th Marine Regiments respectively and the commanding General Task Force Delta, and our normal escort mission for the med-evac aircraft. VMO-2 lost two aircraft in the latter days of October when Major R. M. COOKE crashed into a tree on a night med evac escort in marginal weather. About an hour later, Major V. W. HAZELBAKER flew into the ground trying to locate Major COOKE, fortunately, there were no serious injuries though both helicopters were totally destroyed. Though frequent bad weather hampered flight operations, VMO-2 managed to fly over 1000 hours for MAG-16 and the 1st Marine Aircraft Wing. We are anticipating being able to provide the same service in the winter months ahead.

1 OCT 66: VMC-2 flew our normal daily Danang VIP hops in support of the III MAF, our armed med evac escort ship was able to provide suppressive fire at coordinates BT017524 and BT016534, aiding in the successful evacuation of 1 U.S. and 1 ARVN casualty. In the Dong Ha area, one "Huey" with armed escort made an emergency retraction of a reconnaissance team in contact with the enemy. Several newspaper correspondents were carried to ZD985612 in the Operation "Prairie" operating area.

2 OCT 66: The med evac armed gunship provided covering fire on two separate occasions as the evacuation helicopter received four hits on one mission and sniper fire on another. Six hundred rounds of 7.62 mm were expended. Two gunships in the Dong Ha area provided cover for a CH-46A lift of the 2nd Battalion of the 5th Marines to YD081614.

3 OCT 66: The med evac ship flew in support of HMM-263 to 8 different zones. On the last mission, a V.C.S. was spotted swimming down the river. Upon investigation, the gunship received five hits from AT984586 of .80 cal. automatic weapons fire. Two gunships at Dong Ha were launched in support of HMM-263 lifting one ARVN Battalion. Two aircraft were placed at the disposal of the CG Task Force "Delta" for command and control liaison. Finally, in the same area, four "Hueys" were ordered to perform an emergency extraction of a five man reconnaissance team from the 1st Force Reconnaissance Co. The mission was completed without incident.

4 OCT 66: VMC-2 flew several escort missions involving ARVN med evacs. On one of these the enemy fired upon the evac aircraft from across a river. The escort bird immediately placed suppressive fire upon the area indicated by the ground forces. In response, the enemy popped many yellow smoke grenades and firing ceased. Two Thousand rounds of 7.62mm ammunition were expended. Four "Hueys" were involved in an insertion and two retractions of three different five man reconnaissance teams in the Dong Ha area. Around 1200, one slick "Huey" was launched to search for a missing member of one of these teams. He was not found on this trip, so the Sparrow Hawk reaction Force was alerted to find the wayward Marine. The force was not launched as the errant Marine, realizing his predicament, popped a yellow smoke grenade from his position when one of the search aircraft flew over him. He was identified and pick-up. The Commanding Officer 4th Marines was taken to the USS Repose, Dong Ha, Khe Sanh, and the CP's of his various battalions. The CG III MAF was carried to Dong Ha to visit 3rd Battalion, 4th Marines and units of the ARVN in the area. While overflying a recently bombed village, the aircraft received a hit with resultant minor damage and minor injury to our distinguished passenger.

5 Oct 66: Two "Hueys" escorted by two Army gunships inserted a five man recon team from 3rd Recon. Battalion, with no incident, in the Dong Ha area. The CO 4th Marines was taken to the CP's of the 3rd Battalion 4th Marines, 2nd Battalion 9th Marines, 3rd Battalion 12th Marines and the 2nd Battalion 5th Marines. On a med evac escort mission, 2 gunships saw V.C./NVA troops on a ridgeline and took them under fire. The enemy dispersed.

6 Oct 66: The Med evac helicopter was escorted to AT875470 for the 3rd Battalion, 9th Marines; to AT921789 for the 4th Battalion, 12th Marines; to AT946679 for an ARVN unit; and to AT931682 for 2nd Battalion, 26th Marines. There was no fire on any of these missions. Our III MAF escort bird took the Chief of Staff III MAF to the U.S.S. REPOSE for change of Command Ceremonies.

7 Oct 66: HMM-263 med evac was escorted on an emergency mission to AT920547, with no incident. An hour later the med evac was sent to BT025625 for the 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines for 1 U.S. casualty. In the evening, the med evac went to Z0144532 to remove on Australian emergency malaria case, without landing. the med evac then removed another emergency U. S. wounded from the position of the 3rd Battalion 1st Marines at Dong Ha. VMO-2 flew one insertion and one extraction plus armed escort for an H-34 on a VIP mission. The Assistant CG of the 1st MAF flew as co-pilot on a reconnaissance hop over the entire Dong Ha operating area. Three "Hueys" were launched on another recon insertion, but the mission was cancelled when the team refused to go in.

8 Oct 66: Several med evac escort missions were flown, all with no fire or incident. Two gunships escorted Ch46As from HMM-265 on a drone recovery mission. No fire was received. Inserts, and med evac missions were flown at Dong Ha, along with our regular Command and Control missions for regimental Commanders

9 Oct 66: The med evac was escorted on two emergency med evacs from BT030648 where three persons were removed from an auto wreck, and from AT953812 for WIA. Later in the day the med evac was sent to BT043620 for one civilian for the 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines and for three WIA at AT075672 for Echo Co., 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines.

10 Oct 66: On a relatively quiet day, the med evac was escorted to BT025625 and to BT067513.

11 Oct 66: Our commitment at Dong Ha required the med evac mission at Danang be fulfilled by VMG-6 of MAG-36. Our status improved during the day and we were able to relieve them at 1800. Our daily VIP commitment in the Danang TACZ was kept.

12 Oct 66: The med evac mission was escorted in the Danang TACZ along with the III MAF VII mission. At Long Ha, TAO-2 flew recon, insertions and extractions: missions without incident.

13 Oct 66: In the Danang area, 12 med evac missions were flown without receiving enemy fire. Two gunships escorted CG III MAF in his "Huey" to Dong Ha to join the party of the Secretary of Defense, who was observing that area. The Secretary, with CG MAC-V was escorted from Dong Ha to the DMZ, to Khe Sanh and back to Dong Ha, later in the day three recon insertions were made.

14 Oct 66: Five insertion and four extractions were made at Dong Ha of five man recon teams. A three man team was launched with escort in two slick "Hueys" to recover an M-79 grenade launcher which had been lost in one of the previous extractions. The weapon was found with no incident. HH-164 was escorted on a troop lift to YN125734. One wounded VC suspect was picked up and taken to Delta med.

15 Oct 66: At Danang six med evac escort missions were flown. One med evac was flown at Thu Bai and one insertion and one extraction were made at Dong Ha to coordinates XD9253 and XD9351 respectively.

16 Oct 66: The CO of the 3rd Marines was transported to ME9857 as part of our Dong Ha command and control mission requirement. We provided armed escort for an emergency extraction of a recon team by HH-164 from coordinates CC1930. Three med evac missions were flown in the Danang TACZ.

17 Oct 66: At Danang, nine med evac missions were flown without incident. Three Hueys provided into coordinates ME8501 without observable effect. CG 1st MAFINE Division was carried to several of the landing areas in the Quang area.

18 Oct 66: On the Danang med evac escort mission, the armed "Huey" was shot down at AT827338 while escorting two CH46A's on a pick up of 30 wounded ARVN. There were no injuries and the plane was left in a secure zone while the crew returned with the CH46A's.

19 Oct 66: The med evac was escorted on 16 missions at Danang with no incident. Gunships escorted HMM-164 in retrieving the downed "Huey" from the previous day. A reaction force was inserted to protect the recovery crews, but there was no contact. A fixed wing strike was controlled at coordinates AT848443 on a suspected enemy position.

20 Oct 66: At Phu Bai, our gunship escorted HMM-263 on three routine med evac missions. On two succeeding recon insertions, the troop helos came under heavy enemy fire and 4000 rounds of 7.62mm and 19 2.75 rockets were delivered in suppressive fire. Artillery strikes were called in following the first mission and air strikes following the second. Neither recon team was able to stay in the zone and both were removed. At Danang 8 med evac missions were flown.

21 Oct 66: One slick carried the CO of the 2nd Battalion, 3rd Marines on reconnaissance of the vicinity of AT849369 to look for a helo landing zone. Later one gunship was launched to escort HMM-164 during the troop lift to AT849369. The landing zone was prepared by fixed wing jets prior to the landing, controlled by VMO-2 TAC (A). The zone was marked by the gunship and cover was flown for the entire mission. The med evac was escorted on 11 missions around Danang. Four recon team insertions and two extractions were made at Dong Ha, both of the later were made under enemy small arms fire. There were no hits nor injuries, however.

22 Oct 66: Four med evac missions were escorted by gunships for 1st Battalion, 9th Marines in the Danang TAOR. One med evac escort was flown for the 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines in the same area. On this mission both the med evac bird and the gunship received heavy enemy fire, each aircraft sustaining several hits, the H34 was forced to land in a secured zone nearby, while the "Huey" made it back to MMAF. A crew from HMM-263 was later escorted to recover the downed H-34. At Dong Ha two "Hueys", escorted by Army gunships, accomplished an extraction of a five man recon team from XD988634. The mission was made extremely hazardous by marginal weather in the landing zone, forcing the escort gunships to orbit away in a clear area. The "Huey" went in alone and extracted the team, which was surrounded by VC/NVA. The team assisted the VMO-2 slick by accurate rifle fire and grenade throwing.

23 Oct 66: One gunship was sent as escort for HMM-265 on an emergency resupply mission south of An Hoa. The mission was cancelled twice, due to the weather. The gunship was able to complete one emergency med evac in the interim. When the weather lifted and the supply mission was launched the escort ship provided close suppressive fire into an area from which the supply birds had received fire. During a gun run, the escort received a hit, striking the gunner on his flack vest. He was unhurt, but thrown across the cabin. The mission was completed and the gunship landed at An Hoa for temporary repairs. Med evacs in the Danang complex were limited to emergency only, as the weather was very poor. At Dong Ha, two recon teams were extracted without incident in marginal weather.

24 Oct 66: On a night med evac escort mission in poor weather, the VMO-2 Executive Officer crashed into a tree and then into the ground. Due to a problem in communications, his accident was not immediately known and it wasn't until an hour later that our Operations Officer launched to look for him, unfortunately, due partly to weather and anxiety, this pilot also flew into the ground. Communications were quickly established by emergency radio and a swift pick up was affected. The first crew was located and all were evacuated without further delay. Injuries were minor, though both aircraft were totally destroyed. As the day progressed, four insertion and retractions of recon teams were made and the various Regimental CO's were taken to their Battalion CP's. The CG III MAF was flown to Dong Ha to visit 2nd Battalion 5th Marines and the 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines. Three Med evacs were escorted in the Danang area with no fire incidents reported.

25 Oct 66: Three Med evacs were escorted for HMM-263 at Danang, there was no fire received.

26 Oct 66: All our available aircraft being at Dong Ha, Our commitments in the Danang TAOR were assumed by VMO-6 from MAG-36. At Dong Ha we flew two recon insert/retractions and three command and control hops with the Regimental CO's and the CG Task Force "Delta"

27 Oct 66: At Dong Ha, VMO-2 escorted 6 med evacs for HMM-161, managed to pick up 7 emergency med evac by one slick from YD935475 for the 2nd Battalion, 9th Marines, and flew 29 sorties in accomplishing five different command and control/VIP missions. Two routine recon team extractions were made, one recon team was inserted. This team ran into enemy in close proximity and was extracted under fire. That same team attempted another insertion approximately 2500 meters to the east of the first zone later that day. Again the enemy was contacted 75 meters from the landing zone. Under a protective screen of fire from Army escort gunships they were again extracted. Fortunately, there were no injuries.

28 Oct 66: Again at Dong Ha, our Danang operations assumed by VMO-6, we attempted another recon team insertion in the vicinity of the previous attempts. This time the mission was incomplete due to weather. Our main effort was extended in carrying the CO, 4th Marines on a reconnaissance of YD520545, XD975566, and the vicinity of YDL82732 to search for three lost Marines. They were not found at this time.

29 Oct 66: On the 29th, 6 of our "Hueys" at Dong Ha flew escort and carried members of the CNO's party. There were no incidents. Three recon team extractions were made later in the day during a break in the weather. In view of this consideration, two recon insertions were attempted but the weather had closed in again forcing cancellation of these missions. The CO of the 4th Marines was taken to the vicinity of YD5055 to view a grounded junk, to YDL48682 and to YDL77687 to make a reconnaissance. The CO 3rd Marines was taken to YD972435 and back to his CP. Two Hops were flown for CG Task Force "Delta" in the area.

30 Oct 66: Two "Huey" slicks with Army gunships escort, retracted five separate five man recon teams from 1st Force recon Battalion and evacuated 5 U.S. WIA from XD974536 for the 2nd Battalion 9th Marines. The CO 4th Marines was carried on two command and control hops as was the CG Task Force Delta. The CO 3rd Marines was carried on one such hop also.

31 Oct 66: Normal III MAF VIP hops, in addition to recon insertions and extractions in the Dong Ha area.

VMO-2 SITREP FOR 4 OCTOBER 1966

VMO-2 SUPPORTED THE III MAF BY FLYING NORMAL LIASION, RECON ESCORT, MED EVAC ESCORT AND ADMINSTRATIVE MISSIONS IN THE DA NANG, PHU BAI AND DONG HA AREAS.

THERE WERE ADDITIONALLEY ESCORT MISSIONS FOR ARVIN MED EVACS, ONE OF WHICH WHERE THE ENEMY, AS CALLED BY THE SUPPORTED UNIT, ACROSS THE RIVER, SHOT AT THE MED EVAC AIRCRAFT. FOLLOWING SUPPRESIVE FIRE FROM MAJ ROBSONS UH-1E HOWEVER THE ENEMY POPPED MANY YELLOW SMOKE GERNADES AND ALL INCOMING FIRE CEASED. ORD. EXP. 2,000 ROUNDS OF 7.62 MM AMO. AND 3 ROCKETS.
