1 April - UH-1E from Khe Sanh enroute to Dong Ha received call that team at XD928331 was in heavy contact with enemy forces. Immediately headed for position. Team called fire from XD932331 and XD928332. VMO-2 Hueys returned fire, putting 4 2.75" rockets on target silencing enemy fire.

2 April - Normal flight operations were conducted.

Hueys fire 7.62mm and 2.75" rockets at enemy, destroying 1 hut, damaging the other, with 1 KMA confirmed and 4 possible KMA's. Did not find Marine.

Returned to MMAF via Con Thien and Khe Sanh.
