



NARRATIVE SUMMARY PART II



- 1 April UH-1E from Khe Sanh enroute to Dong Ha received call that team at XD928331 was in heavy contact with enemy forces. Immediately headed for position. Team called fire from XD932331 and XD928332. VMO-2 Hueys returned fire, putting 4 2.75" rockets on target silencing enemy fire.
- 2 April Normal flight operations were conducted.

Hueys fire 7.62mm and 2.75" rockets at enemy, destroying 1 hut, damaging the other, with 1 KRMA confirmed and 4 possible KRMA's. Did not find Marine.

Ran to aircraft while the mortars were overhead. Started and took off. Climbed to 2000' to call air in on mortar positions. Could not locate them. Returned to pick up CG and party. Returned to MMAF via Con Thien and Khe Sanh.
