VMO-2 FLEW 75 SORTIES, PERFORMED 42 TASKS FOR A TOTAL OF 28.6 FLIGHT HOURS DURING THE PERIOD 312000H-012000H. ALSO 48 PASSENGERS WERE CARRIED IN ROUTINE VIP COMMITMENTS. GUN ESCORTS WERE PROVIDED FOR 8 MED EVAC MISSIONS, 3 EMERGENCY, 3 PROORITY, AND 2 ROUTINE CASUALTIES. THE CASUALTIES WERE BOTH ARVN, CIVILIAN, AND 1ST FORCE RECON PERSONNEL.
