





NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Special Operations:

a. During July 1968, VMO-2 flew a total of 3,418 sorties for a total of 1,645.5 hours. This total includes gunships, slicks, and OV-10A's. During these combat sorties, the pilots accomplished the following tasks:

- (1) Armed Helo Escort
- (2) Visual Reconnaissance
- (3) Fire Fly
- (4) TAC(A)
- (5) VIP
- (6) APD (Airborne Personnel Detection)
- 2. Highlights of the month. The following data is taken from the daily after action reports and is typical of the kind of operations that were preformed by VMO-2 during the month of July 1968.
- 8 July Gunship received one .50 cal round in tail rotor, forcing A/C to land with Echo damage and Gulf injuries.
- 12 July Gunship in support of ROKMC fired rockets at suspected enemy position resulting in 2 KBA.
- 15 July OV-10A observed 2 boats and 7 people along river, nearby were 20-30 fighting holes and 10 bunkers.
- 26 July One OV=10A while in support of E/2/5 in contact, ran 6 flights of fixed-wing and 1 arty mission, resulting in 14 structures destroyed, 6 structures damaged, and 2 bunkers destroyed.
- 28 July Two gunships in support of 1st Recon Bn received and returned fire with BDA reported as 10 enemy killed and 1 structure destroyed.
- 30 July One OV-10A flew emergency blood to Dong Ha.
