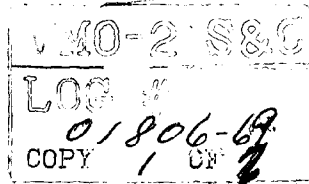

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. During the month of September 1969, VMO-2 flew a total of 4,923 sorties for a total of 2,210.0 hours. These totals are the combined efforts of 17 AH-1G's and 19 OV-10A's assigned this squadron. The following tasks were accomplished:

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2. Highlights of the month. The following data is taken from the daily SITREPS.

During the month of September, Marine Observation Squadron 2 has provided support for operations "Pipestone Canyon" and "Victory Dragon XIV." This squadron's AH-1G s have escorted resupply and medevac aircraft throughout the 1st Marine Division tactical area of responsibility. Additionally, the AH-1G s have provided suppressive fire as required and distinguished themselves on several occasions during emergency extractions of reconnaissance teams.

The squadron's OV-10A s conducted numerous visual reconnaissance missions resulting in several significant sightings. Additionally, the OV-10A's controlled several artillery and airstrike missions causing destruction to both known and suspected enemy positions.

On occasions the OV-10A s and AH-1G s teamed up to provide fire suppression and smoke screening support for the emergency extract of recon teams "Rabbit Hutch", "Grim Reaper", "Parallel Bars", and "Wedding Ring". Additionally, smoke screen support was provided in the accomplishment of several medevac missions.
