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1. During the month of October 1969, VMO-2 flew a total of 3328 sorties for a total of 2212.6 hours. These totals are the combined efforts of 17 AH-1G's and 19 OV-10A's assigned this squadron. The following tasks were accomplished:

- a. Armed Helo Escort
- b. Training
- c. Visual Reconnaissance
- d. Photo Reconnaissance
- e. FAC(A) Forward Air Controller (Airborne)
- f. Artillery Spot
- g. Convoy Escort
- h. Med Evac Escort
- i. Command and Control
- j. APD (Airborne Personnel Detection) Escort

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2. Highlights of the month. The following data is taken from the daily SITREPS.

The month of October, brought the bad weather to I Corps and also brought a small reduction to the total flight time of the squadron. VMO-2 did however continue to fulfill its mission regardless of the foul weather.

Detachment Alpha was formed on 2 October 1969 by verbal order of the Commanding Officer VMO-2, for the purpose of fulfilling a MAG-16 requirement to support the Third Marine Division with visual reconnaissance and FAC(A) aircraft subsequent to the re-deployment of VMO-6. The detachment remained ADCON to MAG-16, but OPCON to Provisional MAG-39. On 9 October the detachment became OPCON to MAG-36 and continued its support of the Third Marine Division for the remainder of the month.

On the 22nd of October VMO-2 participated in the emergency extract of recon team "Big Flower". The extract, executed in darkness and IFR weather conditions, was under the command and control of VMO-2 pilots; both OV-10A and AH-1G. The squadron amassed 47.3 hours in the effort and 122.5 hours for the twenty four hour period. These figures indicate the dedication and professionalism of all VMO-2 personnel.

Through participation in this extract, VMO-2 received well done's from: CG, 1st MarDiv; CG, 1st MAF, CO, MAG-16 and was privileged with a visit from MajGen Thrash, to personally congratulate the pilots involved.

VMO-2 continued its support of ground troops through FAC(A) control by the OV-10A's and fire suppression from both the Cobra and the Bronco. Both aircraft performed despite adverse weather and the squadron compiled 2212.6 total flight hours, only 291.9 hours off the one month record set in August 1969.
