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PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. The month of February 1970 proved to be a busy one for VMO-2 during which several "firsts" were achieved by the Squadron. Statistically, the squadron flew a total of 1179.6 hours, 561 sorties, and accomplished 901 tasks during a month which saw accumulated missions hampered by several days of poor weather. During this period, VMO-2 acquired 91 significant sightings for 1st Marine Aircraft Wing Intelligence, and controlled 108 flights of fixed wing aircraft on targets within the 1st Marine Division TAOB. The most significant historical event occurred during the period 1-4 February when the squadron accomplished a move from MAG-16 to Marine Aircraft Group 11. VMO-2 had been an integral part of MAG-16 since its arrival in RVN in May 1965. The logistically and operationally complex transfer of resources from Marble Mountain Air Facility to Danang Air base was accomplished while flying a normal daily flight schedule. On 2 February, when all OV-10A aircraft were flown into their new home, 65.3 flight hours were logged and 37 sorties flown.

The association with MAG 11 has provided several advantages. The squadrons hangar facilities and spaces are a vast improvement over those at Marble Mountain. Operating from Danang Air Base has provided a substantial increase in safety and operational effectiveness. The close proximity of the photographic services of VMCF-1 has greatly increased the effectiveness of the squadron's photo missions. Because of the closeness to the Division Headquarters, coordination has been improved significantly. The improvement in coordination can be clearly seen in the mission 74. VMO-2 now controls and briefs mission 74 which has improved the effectiveness of the mission considerably.

The OV-10A received a new weapon during the month, the CPU-2N(XN1) 20mm aircraft gunpod interim, that proved its effectiveness on 19 February. 1st Lt. Dennis Darnell discovered a company of NVA running from an RVN force on an open beach area south of Danang. After running his onboard ordnance on the fleeing NVA who were fast dispersing themselves in the sand dunes, he called artillery and naval gunfire on the enemy. His aircraft was equipped with the new 20mm gun in addition to the 2.75 WP/HE rockets and 7.62 machine guns. He was personally credited with 30 KRA'S. The OV-10A promises to wield more suppressive firepower in the future, since during this month, two of VMO's "Broncos" were constituted with an ordnance load consisting of 4 M-60 internal guns, 2 SUU-11 mini-guns, 1 20mm gun pod, and two seven shot 2.75 W/P Smoke rocket pods. This package is capable of delivering a devastating 14,500 rounds per minute, available for use on fleeting targets and or suppressive fire while awaiting strike aircraft.

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2. VMO-2 further established itself as an integral part of MAG 11 by working tactically with other aircraft in the Group. On 25 February, Captain D. B. Herbert ran a flight of 2 A-6 aircraft with 56 D2 conical bombs on a strong DCP reading within the 1st Marine Division TAOR. While working with the 1st MARDIV, ROKMC and III MAF, performing its missions of visual reconnaissance, forward air control (airborne), convoy escort, and artillery spotting, it was obvious to all concerned that while VMO-2 had moved its base, it had provided ever increasing support.

5. Following the fly away at 1545 the remainder of aircraft not required to complete the flight schedule will be launched by sections as they are readied for flight.

b. Fly away schedule: To be published IAW daily frags.

c. IFR Operations: Will be conducted IAW existing instructions and as further amplified by the DNG operations brief.

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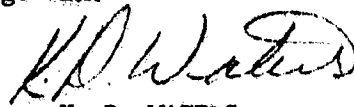

b. Preparation. All personal baggage and effects will be packed by owners in containers suitable for transport by truck. All squadron property will be packed in accordance with Ref (a). Aircraft to be flown with ordnance loads as per squadron flight schedule.

c. Allocation of Supplies and Equipment. Advance Wave will draw supplies as required from Logistics Department. No other requirements anticipated.

Daylight Move Only is authorized at this time. Small, highly pilferable personal gear may be hand-carried. Cameras, radios, etc.

- b. Advance Details.

(1) The Advance Wave will be charged with securing the sqv drop area as described in figures (1) through (4). This will include the

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billeting area and the hangar formerly occupied by VMFA 542.
 Detailed duties as prescribed by OIC Advance Wave will include
 but are not limited to:

(a) Insuring integrity of squadron property, both buildings,
 and subsequently arriving equipment and personal belongings,
 locks to be provided by S-4.

(b) Cleaning working spaces, enlisted billeting spaces, and
 heads, and maintaining same.

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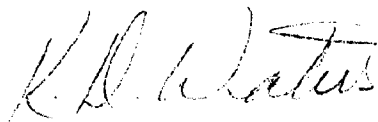
