NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. VMO-2 continued to prove an invaluable asset in the Marine Air-Ground team during the month of June 1970. The squadron flew a total of 1594.2 combat hours in 750 sorties in support of U. S. Army, Marine, Republic of Korea and Republic of Vietnam ground units. The 401 visual reconnaissance missions flown were responsible for locating many enemy base areas which were subsequently attacked with supporting arms, including 171 flights of fixed-wing airstrikes. VMO-2 contributed the following BDA during the month: 57 bunkers and, 118 structures destroyed, 3 bunkers damaged, 60 secondary explosions, 37 secondary fires, and 25 confirmed and 11 probable enemy KBA's. In addition, the "Broncos" performed 7 sensor drops in support of the 1st MAW.

During the month, VMO-2 coordinated and performed a major role in the employment of a unique air delivered weapon. The concept of Operation Thrashlite utilized CH-53 helicopters to deliver 20 fifty gallon drums of napalm carried as an external load and intensive A-6 and F-4 airstrikes using 1000 pound bombs for heavy targets. The OV-10A, subsequent to the delivery, ignited the napalm with 2.75" rockets and 5" Zuni rockets. This unique concept produced results more devastating than a conventional ARCLITE largely due to the large area burned and the accuracy of the fixed wing bombing. A total of 3 of these strikes were controlled by VMO-2, in which 4000 barrels were delivered and 71 airstrikes controlled. The strikes culminated on 16 June with a drop of 1400 barrels of napalm and 32 airstrikes in support of an ARVN strike west of Thuong Duc. After the air strikes, the ground units swept through the area, discovering 21 KBA and numerous blood trails. Further investigation revealed six graves containing 8 NVA bodies, and 20 destroyed bunkers. Estimates placed at least 4 bodies in each bunker, but detailed investigation was unfeasible.

As in the month of May, VMO-2 continued to provide support to the beleaguered forces at Thuong Duc. On 10 June, Hostage Six (LtCol Moriarty) controlled two flights of fixed wing on an active enemy mortar site in the vicinity of Thuong Duc, resulting in one secondary explosion. Hostage Bill (Capt Paulson) was subsequently called to suppress another mortar site, and fired onboard ordnance until the fixed-wing attack aircraft, LB 555, arrived. The ensuing airstrike resulted in 1 secondary fire and 1 secondary explosion.

Hostage Hornet (1/Lt Hunt) was escorting a flight of helicopters re-supplying Thuong Duc, when incoming mortar fire forced the helicopters to withdraw. Hornet located the enemy position, and controlled two airstrikes resulting in the destruction of the site and one secondary explosion.

A devastating airstrike in support of ARVN troops in contact with an enemy force near Thung Duc was controlled by Hostage Six on 11 June. A total of ten flights delivered their ordnance under the direction of Hostage Six, resulting in an enemy withdrawal and two secondary explosions. All aircraft received heavy automatic weapons fire, but 1000lb bombs were delivered within 350 meters of friendly units, napalm within 50 meters, and CV-10A ordnance as close as 15 meters before contact was broken. This action demonstrated the professionalism and skill required of all VMO-2 pilots and aircrews.

1st Marine Division and 1st Force Reconnaissance units continued to receive the welcome support of VMO-2 in several actions this month. On 28 June, Hostage Six employed onboard ordnance and one flight of A-1's to enable recon team Donahue to break contact with an enemy unit equipped with dogs, who enclosed them on three sides, and be successfully extracted.

14 June found Hostage Rum (Maj Hatfield) directing the extraction of team Flakey Snow, which was in danger of being overrun by a superior enemy force. In extremely marginal weather conditions, Rum directed his fire and the ordnance of AHLG gunships within 10 meters of the team, enabling them to break contact and be subsequently extracted.

VMO-2 provided invaluable intelligence to the 1st Marine Aircraft Wing as a result of the deep reconnaissance mission "75's flown during the month. On several of these missions, through intensive visual reconnaissance, Hostage located a large enemy base area containing an estimated 100 structures. Subsequently, on 12 June, Hostage Trapper controlled three flights of attack aircraft on this area, resulting in 1 large secondary explosion, 5 bunkers and 9 structures destroyed. Trapper returned to the area on 13 June, directed further airstrikes on the area, and observed 14 structures demolished and one secondary explosion two minutes after completion of the attack.

14 June found Hostage Lady (Lt Darnell) in the same area, controlling two airstrikes resulting in 10 destroyed structures and two extremely large secondary explosions. On 18 and 19 June, Lady again directed the attack in this base area, contributing 12 destroyed structures and 3 large secondary explosions to the 1st MAW BDA.
