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NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. During September, VMO-2 flew 612 combat sorties for a total of 1325 flight hours. The squadron's FAC(A)'s controlled 254 flights of fixed wing aircraft resulting in an aggregate BDA of 27 bunkers destroyed, 59 structures destroyed, 3 structures damaged, 3 caves destroyed, 46 secondary explosions, 47 secondary fires, 5 KBMA, 48 landing zone preparations, and 10,725 meters of treeline destroyed.

Fifty-three (53) deep reconnaissance missions were flown for the 1st Marine Aircraft Wing, involving the control of 20 flights of fixed wing air strikes on suspected base camps, supply routes and lines of communication.

A helicopter assault for the 3rd Battalion 5th Marines encountered heavy enemy fire on the 2nd of September. The lead CH-46 was forced to shut down in the zone while his two wingmen returned to base with numerous hits and a wounded co-pilot. Hostage P. J. (Capt JONES) controlled five flights of aircraft with 500 pound retarded bombs and napalm. This allowed the friendly troops to secure the LZ and advance toward the enemy positions. All flights, including P. J. received heavy fire.

Hostage aircraft supported the 2nd Battalion 7th Marines conducting operation "Imperial Lake" over a period of several days in the Que Son mountains (AT 9844). On the 5th of September, Hostage Blue (Maj OLSEN) was diverted to cover this operation after four CH-46's had been shot up while attempting emergency medevacs for the operation. The fourth CH-46 was shot down and the crew was rescued by another CH-46. A fifth CH-46 reported taking two WIA MC attempting a medavac. Blue was relieved on station by Hostage P. J. (Capt JONES) but both were unable to deliver suppressive fire because the enemy positions were within friendly lines.

The next day the situation had not changed appreciably with friendly troops located throughout the target area. Another CH-46 was shot down. Hostage Able (Maj WATERS) coordinated three other OV-10A aircraft (Capt LEPO, Maj CARLSON, and 1st Lt HUDSON) in suppressing the fire with onboard ordnance while requesting a scramble flight of straight napalm. The enemy had selected a rocky gorge area with numerous caves and the friendly forces were too close in all directions for hard ordnance (bombs) to be used. Hostage Junkman (Maj CARLSON) layed a smoke screen with white phosphorus rockets to allow Echo company to move away from the target area permitting an airstrike to be run. Hostage Eagle (1st Lt HUDSON) then relieved Able to run the napalm strike. Eagle observed a large secondary explosion and numerous small secondaries believed to be small arms ammunition exploding.

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On September 7, Maj OLSEN commenced the day by conducting an airstrike on this same target using napalm. Friendly forces continued to take casualties and the resupply/medevac helicopters still continued to take fire. The battalion commander requested 1000 pound bombs be used, but the friendlies completely encircled the target and at points were within 500 meters. The night of the 8th Hostage Junkman (Maj CARLSON) supported a medevac attempt with parachute flare illumination. Continuing on through the 9th of September numerous airstrikes were run using nothing heavier than 500 pound bombs, but the fire incidents continued. The friendlies withdrew to defiladed positions allowing heavier ordnance to be used, although the margin for error was small. With friendlies 800 to 1500 meters at the 3, 6, 9, and 12 o'clock positions to the target a successful strike with fourteen, 1000 pound bombs with delayed fuzes was controlled by Hostage Bravo (Capt SABIA). All of these big bombs were right on target and caused a secondary explosion. For the first time in five days no ground fire was taken from this area and the ground units were allowed to sweep the area without taking a casualty.

Lieutenant Colonel J. M. Moriarty was relieved by Major C. B. Olsen as Commanding Officer of Marine Observation Squadron Two in a change of command ceremony on the 17th of September 1970. LtCol Moriarty was ordered by Headquarters Marine Corps to proceed to Camp Pendleton, California to assume command of Marine Light Helicopter Squadron-267.

On 18 September Hostage Bravo (Capt SABIA) was assigned to support recon team "Swift Scout" who had heard three mortars firing throughout the day, although no friendly units had reported any incoming rounds. An airstrike and artillery mission resulted in silencing of the mortars. However the following day "Swift Scout" again heard the mortars firing. Hostage Zulu (1st/Lt SVENSON) conducted an artillery mission while awaiting a scrambled flight of A-4's. The airstrike was run on the mortars closest to the team and resulted in one intense secondary fire while "Swift Scout" reported hearing six secondary explosions. The mortars were not heard again and it was believed that one of the mortar positions was destroyed.

From an observation post, "Madhater 84" informed Hostage Junkman (Maj CARLSON) they had observed two VC with packs and rifles. Junkman received clearance from warcloud "M" to fire onboard ordnance. Both VC were believed to be hit but they stumbled into heavy foliage and could not be confirmed as KIA's.

VMO-2 aircraft assisted "I" company 3rd BN. 7th Marines on 20 September when they were taken under fire by snipers. Hostage Romeo (Maj ROMAN) and Hostage Pogo (Maj DYE) covered the tactical withdrawal from an exposed position so that two emergency WIA MC could be medevaced. Although the sniper fire was silenced initially, the medevac helicopter took hits while lifting from the zone. Again Romeo and Pogo expended their onboard ordnance

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until the situation had stabilized.

Later in the day Hostage Hoot (1st/Lt GIBSON) delivered onboard ordnance in support of "INDIA" company including laying a smoke screen to cover their movement. "LIMA" company in the same operating area was supported by a CAS mission controlled by Hoot which resulted in two secondary explosions and one large secondary fire.

Hostage Farmer (1st/Lt PARKER) had an active flight while supporting the 1st Reconnaissance Bn. on 27 September 1970. While supporting recon teams "Rummage" and "Offspring", team "Offspring" encountered four NVA. The team received one NVA MC while recovering the equipment off two KIA NVA. Farmer layed down suppressive fire within twenty meters of the team while directing the team to an extract zone. Fire support using onboard ordnance was continued until the successful extraction was completed. An artillery fire mission was called in on the enemy position until a bingo fuel state was reached. Hostage P. J. (Capt JONES) arrived on the scene to continue the observed artillery mission when team "Rummage" made contact. Onboard ordnance was used to suppress the enemy fire, assisting in the helicopter extraction of the team. Again artillery was called in on "Rummage's" extraction site. Hostage Rum (Maj HATFIELD) arrived to relieve P. J. in the control of both fire missions. More than 150 rounds of HE artillery were shot into both extraction zones resulting in one large secondary explosion from the area where team "Offspring" had made contact.

On 28 September Hostage Hawk (Maj CONE) controlled two flights of fixed-wing air which resulted in four secondary explosions, one secondary fire and a 122mm rocket that was blown 400 meters out of the target area by a 250 pound bomb (confirmed by the ground unit.) Hawk further expended his ordnance gaining two more secondary explosions.

During September WIC-2 recieved a new mission to support U. S. Army convoys twice a day every other day while traveling Hai Van Pass to the north of Danang. Twenty-seven sorties were flown for 53.4 hours of support. Although this mission was routine and uneventful, on the 29th the convoy was hit during both missions on the south side of the pass. On the afternoon mission Hostage Zulu (1st/Lt SVENSON) observed two RPG rounds impact near the convoy along with muzzle flashes from the ambush site. After the convoy commander marked the target for positive identification and gave a clearance to fire, Zulu layed down suppressive fire even though severely hampered by clouds and the mountainous terrain. The convoy successfully escaped without receiving any casualties while receiving an estimated 100 rounds of small arms fire.

The end of the month was marked with the commencing of the monsoon season and its accompanying rains. Continuous rain and low ceilings prevented any combat sorties from being flown on the 30th of September.
