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NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Sever monsoon weather prevented the launching of any combat sorties on the first and second of October. Only three missions were flown on the third.

On the morning of the fourth the weather cleared. "CHARLIE" Co. 1st Battalion, 1st Marines, located at hill 52 received mortar fire. Hostage Eagle (Lt Hudson) located the mortar position and directed two flights of air resulting in five bunkers destroyed, two secondary explosions, and one secondary fire. On board ordnance was employed and 40mm from hill 52 was adjusted on target. Hostage Bulldog (Capt Sweeney) relieved Eagle and employed his onboard ordnance while adjusting 106mm recoilless rifle fire from hill 52. Both Hostage aircraft and the two flights of fixed wing were fired upon by the enemy. Other Hostage aircraft supplied observation and FAC(A) support throughout the day.

Later in the day Hostage Eagle (Lt Hudson) and Hostage Big (Capt Lepo) covered recon teams "Wage Earner" and "Clay Pipe". Eagle received credit for three confirmed enemy killed using onboard ordnance. Both teams were successfully extracted.

Hill 52 came under mortar and small arms fire again on the fifth of October. VMO-2 aircraft were on station throughout the day. Airstrikes were run to suppress the mortar fire and Hostage Junkman (Maj Carlson) controlled one flight at 2015H under flare illumination. This attack resulted in a very bright secondary explosion from a napalm drop.

The morning of the sixth of October required more assistance to hill 52. Hostage Whiskey (Capt Ruymann) directed onboard ordnance from four other OV-10A Bronco's onto a target from which helicopters had received fire.

While working with recon team "Air Hose" on the eighth of October, Hostage Eagle (Lt Hudson) gained two kills which were confirmed by the team. Hostage Lima (Lt Hallin) relieved Eagle and a successful extraction was completed. Hostage Fireplug (Lt Tullis) assisted by laying smoke with 2.75 inch W. P. rockets.

Hostage Fireplug (Lt Tullis) assisted recon team "Auditor" on the 10th with onboard ordnance. After the team broke contact they were successfully extracted and artillery fire was directed into the area.

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A UH-1E crashed in the vicinity of fire support base Rider on the 11th. Hostage Farmer (Lt Parker), Whiskey (Capt Luyman), and Lima (Lt Hallin) covered the rescue and salvage of the crew and equipment. Later the aircraft wreckage was ordered destroyed by 1st MAW. Hostage Bravo (Capt Sabia) expended 76 white phosphorous rockets, causing secondary fires that consumed all but the tail boom.

Recon team "Screen Test" made contact on the 12th receiving one WIA. Hostage Bushie (Lt Loudon) was relieved by Hostage Cajun (Capt Verbaal) to complete the medevac and team extraction. Special night flights were scheduled over the succeeding three nights due to the high threat of a rocket attack on Danang Air Base.

On the 13th Hostage Bushie (Lt Loudon) was credited with a KBA using onboard ordnance in support of team "Wage Earner". Bushie received heavy automatic weapons fire without taking any hits and the team had two minor WIA's. Hostage Bravo (Capt Sabia) with his wingman Gringo (Lt Williams) were diverted from a helicopter escort mission to lay down suppressive fire. Gringo had to return to base early to rearm, refuel, and pick up an aerial observer. Gringo returned to relieve Bravo. After the team set up a 360 degree defense they started receiving small arms fire. Onboard ordnance of Gringo accounted for 5 KBA's that were confirmed by the team. This action was concluded with the extraction of the team and darkness.

Hostage Roach (Lt Davidson) controlled an airstrike in support of Charlie company, 1st Battalion, 1st Marines on October 14th. The strike started one secondary fire in an ammo storage area, which burned for twelve minutes. This in turn started three more secondary fires which resulted in three secondary explosions from a concealed entrance to the storage area. The fires and explosions accounted for the destruction of two well camouflaged bunkers.

Flights were terminated on the afternoon of the 15th and all up status aircraft were evacuated to Ubon, except four standby aircraft, due to an impending typhoon.

Scheduled missions were resumed on the 17th. Hostage Stud (Capt Goodwin) observed the launching of 122mm rockets near Thuong Duc. A flight of fixed wing was scrambled resulting in one large secondary explosion on the launch site.

Marine Observation Squadron Two was assigned the task of coordinating an all Marine resupply of the Thuong Duc Special Forces camp. During this period, multifarious tactics were employed to accomplish this mission one to the numerous mortar, rocket, and anti-aircraft sites in the resupply area. An excellent example of the coordination necessary was a resupply

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conducted on the 13th of October. Hostage Whiskey (Capt Ruymann) and Hostage Hawk (Maj Cone) were assigned two separate targets on the high terrain overlooking Thuong Duc (one to the north and the other to the south on the terrain referred to as the "tennis courts"). As the resupply helicopters made their approach while being covered by helicopter gunships, Whiskey and Hawk simultaneously layed a smoke screen with white phosphorus rockets to shield the transports from known anti-aircraft sites. This effort was enhanced by two A-4 aircraft laying smoke screens as directed by the FAC aircraft. Two CAP flights were held on station in the event enemy activity warranted their commitment. This was not the case, but both flights were employed at the conclusion of the mission by simultaneously running them on the two targets. This resulted in three small secondary fires on the north target and one large secondary fire on the south target.

On the nineteenth, recon teams "Road Test" and "Grim Reaper" were in contact with the enemy. Hostage aircraft relieved each other on station throughout the day to assist these teams. "Road Test" was extracted later that day.

Early next morning Hostage Eagle (Lt Hudson) was scrambled during darkness in the night FAC aircraft. A CIDG unit was under heavy contact. With a 1200-1400 foot overcast ceiling in the target area, Eagle directed two flights of air, an Air Force AC-119 gunship, and used his own onboard ordnance. All aircraft were exposed to heavy automatic weapons fire estimated to be of 12.7mm caliber for 7-10 seconds duration on each pass. The ground unit later confirmed 36 KBA's. Hostage P. J. (Capt Jones) relieved Eagle and controlled three more flights of Marine Fixed Wing air support. These flights also received ground fire.

From the 25th of October until the end of the month low ceilings, poor visibility and high winds seriously reduced flight operations. Most of the missions conducted were area weather checks and terminated in an instrument approach in nearly IFR minimum weather.
