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NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. The month of November started off with Hostage Eagle (Lt HUDSON) supporting a helicopter resupply of Thuong Duc. Lt Hudson used the smoke aircraft (four 19 shot WP rockets) to lay a smoke screen and received ground fire from the area. Later in the day Eagle also received fire while assisting recon team "Wage Earner".

Hostage Six (Maj OLSEN) was credited with three KBA and one probable by recon team "Saddlebag" on 3 November. "Saddlebag" was supported by other Hostage Aircraft throughout the day, but with negative further BDA.

On the fourth, Hostage Rum (Maj HATFIELD) observed 12-14 VC/NVA in green uniforms run into a treeline. Further VR of the area resulted in ground fire as reported by a nearby friendly unit. Rum received clearance to fire his onboard ordnance with negative results determined. An airstrike was directed on this same target using napalm and snakeye bombs. Hostage Bulldog (Capt SWEENEY) relieved Rum on station and observed 8 VC/NVA but was unable to fire ordnance due to the target not being cleared. Later in the day, Hostage Easy (Maj EVANS) assisted a convoy he was covering by calling for a medevac helicopter when a truck hit a mine.

Early on the morning of the fifth, Hostage Big (Capt LEPO) ran a flight of air for "Kilo" company, 5th Marines that caused a secondary fire which burned for five minutes. Further probing of the area with onboard ordnance resulted in two small secondary fires. Hostage Eagle (Lt HUDSON) relieved Big on station. Eagle spotted 4 VC/NVA crossing a stream and was cleared to fire onboard ordnance resulting in 2 VC/NVA WIA. These WIA's were captured by the ground unit along with two KIA's and enemy equipment (1 AK47, 1 Chicom Grenade, Documents and Web Belts). Eagle received one small arms round through the left aileron. Also on the fifth, Hostage Six (Maj OLSEN) and Hostage Easy (Maj EVANS) delivered suppressive fire in support of recon team "Prime Cut", who was under fire. Later, Hostage Fireplug (Lt TULLIS) and Hostage Junkman (Maj CARLSON) covered the team's extraction.

On 6 November, Hostage Cajun (Capt VERBAEL) scrambled a flight of A-4's in response to enemy sighted by friendlies from Hill 52. The flight put 100% of its ordnance on target and had one secondary explosion.

Weather in the Danang TAOR was very poor between the eighth and twelfth. On the thirteenth, Hostage Cajun (Capt VERBAEL) fired at 2 VC/NVA while in support of a CUPP unit which later confirmed one KBA. Further contact with the enemy required Cajun to deliver fire support and run a CAS strike resulting in 4 KBA (probables). Later the CUPP confirmed 3 of the KBA's. While in support of "India" company, Fifth Marines on the fourteenth, Hostage Bushie (Lt LOUDON) received ground fire. Hostage Pogo (Maj DYE) relieved Bushie on station and directed an artillery mission on this target.

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Hostage Easy (Maj EVANS) directed Hostage Bravo (Capt SABIA) and Hostage Whiskey (Capt RUYMANN) on the emplantation of aerial delivered sensors. Fifty-seven sensors were dropped in the Quang Tri and the Khe San areas in support of the U. S. Army. On the return flight from this mission, Easy was diverted to team "Icebound" who was in contact. Hostage Turtle (Maj CARROLL) relieved Easy after sunset for the successful extraction of the team.

The following day, November fifteenth, Hostage Bravo (Capt SABIA) directed Hostage Easy (Maj EVANS) on a sensor drop in support of the Army of the Republic of Vietnam. Twelve sensors were delivered on three target areas west of Hue. The same day, Hostage Lima (Lt HALLIN) covered the movement of Kilo company, First Marines that was under a gas attack. Lima fired onboard ordnance at 10 VC/NVA spotted 150 meters away from the friendlies with unknown results.

Again the weather deteriorated until the nineteenth when it cleared. Hostage Oscar (Maj OLSON) ran two flights of fixed wing on a trans-shipment point reported by Hostage Bulldog (Capt SWEENEY) earlier on the nineteenth. The resultant BDA was one trail cut, one secondary explosion on the trail, two 30' boats destroyed, and three storage bunkers destroyed.

Action for the rest of the month was scattered and light with poor weather hampering most missions. Hostage Lima (Lt HALLIN) assisted "Foxtrot" Company, 2nd BN., 1st Marines by covering their extraction at dusk. Hostage Eagle (Lt HUDSON) on the 21st was fired upon but did not receive any hits while on a deep visual reconnaissance mission. Hostage Roach (Lt DAVIDSON) fired onboard ordnance at two VC with unknown results while supporting Recon team "Prime Cut" on the 22nd. Hostage Shadow (LtCol JANZ) spotted 5 VC/NVA wearing black P. J.'s and fired on them after receiving clearance with unknown results observed. Hostage Junkman (Maj CARLSON) and Hostage Oscar (Maj OLSON) supported team "Nail Brush" who was in contact with 2 VC/NVA on the 24th.

VMO-2 initiated a field evaluation series of test drops using the CBU-55/B Low Speed Fuel Air Explosive weapon. Seventy-two weapons have been programed to be delivered in various dive angles and release parameters to test the weapon's effectiveness in a combat environment. The first drop was made on the 25th of November by Hostage Papaya (Col POMMERENK) the MAG-11 Commanding Officer. It is anticipated that further testing will prove the merits of this weapon and lend itself to further diversification of the OV-10A. Two aircraft modification programs were commenced during November. An automatic weapons release system will be installed in conjunction with the CBU-55/B tests to optimize a salvo release of the three weapons that can be carried on the OV-10A. Also, the KY-28 cipher capability will be added to all squadron aircraft for secure UHF and VHF communications.

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On the 27th of November Major C. B. Olsen was relieved by LtCol E. P. JANZ as Commanding Officer of Marine Observation Squadron Two at a change of command ceremony. Major Olsen assumed the duties of the Executive Officer of the squadron.

The remainder of the month was uneventful due to the resumption of the monsoon weather.
