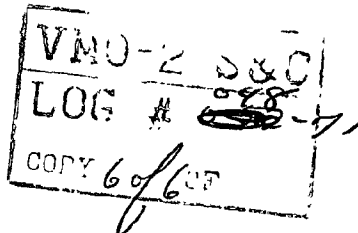

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. The month of December started much as November had ended. Marginal weather restricted flying to low level visual recon, support of troops in contact and test drops of the CBU-55 fuel air explosive as part of the combat evaluation program.

Hostage Bushie (Lt Loudon), on 1 December, supported recon team Cayenne who was receiving fire. He departed after contact was broken.

On the 2nd, Hostage Easy (Maj Evans), Hostage Cherokee (Capt Payne) and Hostage Bravo (Capt Sabia) continued test dropping the CBU-55.

Hostage Bushie controlled a flight of fixed wing on a cave complex on Charley Ridge. Their BDA included 2 secondary explosions.

Hostage Easy (Maj Evans) covered a troop insert of recon team Lunga Point at AT 923430 on 3 December. He was relieved on station by Hostage Bushie (Lt Loudon). Bushie was relieved by Hostage Lima (Lt Hallin) and diverted to run air strikes on VC/NVA in bunkers for Fox 2-1. Meanwhile, Lima, about 2000 meters west of Bushie, was using onboard ordnance to suppress hostile fire for Lunga Point. At bingo fuel, he was relieved by Hostage Victor (Lt Ventris) who continued the coverage until the team was extracted.

CBU-55 testing continued with Hostage Bravo (Capt Sabia) dropping the ordnance under the control of Hostage Rum (Maj Hatfield).

On 4 December, Hostage Rum (Maj Hatfield) was diverted from covering an area sweep to suppress enemy fire for recon team Donny Brook in the Que Sons.

Hostage Bulldog (Capt Sweeney) ran several flights of air on a bunker at AT 985307, resulting in several secondary explosions, sustained fires and several bunkers destroyed.

On the morning of 5 December, Hostage Bravo (Capt Sabia) and Hostage Victor (Lt Ventris) flew to Chu Lai to work with the Army in a sensor placement program. Hostage Fireplug (Lt Tullis) controlled Hostage Rum (Maj Hatfield) and Hostage Easy (Maj Evans) on a CBU-55 drop. The BDA disclosed destruction or damage to buildings, bunkers and trenching.

On 6 December, Hostage Eagle (Lt Hudson) controlled Hostage Rum (Maj Hatfield) on a CBU-55 drop, with damage to one building, two bunkers and a probable KBA.

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Hostage Bushie (Lt Loudon) was sent to cover recon team Cayenne, surrounded and under fire. Bushie covered the team with onboard ordnance, called for an extract and ran air on the area when the team, still taking fire, had been lifted out.

On 7 December, Hostage Big (Capt Lepo) with Hostage Cherokee (Capt Payne) dropped three CBU-55's, uncovering four bunkers and destroying three buildings. That afternoon Hostage Easy (Maj Evans) controlled two CBU-55 drops. Neither weapon exploded due to systems malfunction.

Hostage Lima (Lt Hallin) covered the medevac of three Marines wounded by booby traps at AT 811578, then he controlled an air strike and delivered his onboard ordnance in the area, resulting in sustained fires and several explosions.

Weather prevented flying on 8-10 December.

On the eleventh, the CBU-55 was dropped by Hostage Six (LtCol Janz). No BDA was given.

On 12 December, Hostage Bushie located and called air strikes on a base camp complex in the Bullpens. He was relieved by Hostage Roach, who called more air on target. The BDA disclosed 12 buildings destroyed or damaged, 1 bunker damaged and the loss to the VC/NVA of their crypto operator when a 2.75 WP rocket exploded inside his bunker.

On 13 December, Hostage Rum (Maj Hatfield) dropped six CBU-55's for an L.Z. prep. No BDA was given.

On 14 December, Hostage Victor (Lt Ventris) took fire supporting recon team Thin Man in the Que Sons. Victor was relieved by Hostage Farmer (Lt Parker), who covered the insertion of a reaction team. Hostage Roach (Lt Davidson) relieved Farmer and stayed on station until diverted to another mission.

In a different Operation Hostage Pete (Lt Benson) relieved Comprise 77 on station, controlled two Scarface aircraft on target, and received a confirmed BDA of several structures destroyed and 3 KBA.

The following day, 15 December, Hostage Lima (Lt Hallin) controlled Hostage Easy (Maj Evans) and Hostage Fox (Maj Olsen) on CBU-55 drops. Hostage Cherokee (Capt Payne) was the FAC(A) for a Comprise UH-1E on a CBU-55 test drop. The BDA showed good delivery; good weapon performance.

Hostage Rum (Maj Hatfield) and Hostage Six (LtCol Janz) conducted the CBU-55 drop on 17 December. No BDA was given.

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Hostage Stud (Capt Goodwin) was diverted from a VR mission to cover recon team Road Test under fire. Stud laid down suppressive fire with onboard ordnance and coordinated the fire of Broncos and Cobras. Hostage Pogo (Maj Dye) relieved Stud to cover the extraction. Pogo called air strikes, provided suppressive fire while the team moved to their LZ, and covered the area with artillery before being relieved by Hostage Smoke (Maj Morris).

In a separate action, Hostage Bushie (Lt Loudon) covered recon team Swift Scout, who had made contact in the afternoon. Bushie called Dingo for helicopters to extract the team and was delivering on board ordnance when he lost an engine pulling off the target and was forced to RTB. Hostage Victor (Lt Ventris) was diverted from a FAC(A) mission to cover the extract. Victor called air strikes, controlled Scarface aircraft and called Hostage Six (LtCol Janz) on target for delivery of onboard ordnance. Victor was relieved by Hostage Junkman (Maj Carlson). Air strikes were continued at night on the area under flares.

Hostage Lima (Lt Hallin) controlled Hostage Rum (Maj Hatfield) on the CEU-55 drop on 18 December. Hostage Fireplug (Lt Tullis) controlled a MAGPIE flight (Australian pilots in a B-57) on a preplanned target.

On 20 December, Hostage Farmer (Lt Parker) received a BDA of three probable KIA working with Night Scholar.

Hostage Rum (Maj Hatfield) covered a recon team in contact on 22 December. Rum fired on seven enemy hiding in a hootch. The hootch was destroyed. No other BDA was given.

Hostage Six (LtCol Janz) was the target of ground fire while supporting recon teams Prime Out and Swift Scout in contact. Six was relieved by Hostage Rum (Maj Hatfield), who continued suppressive fire until the medevac helicopter removed the wounded. After the extraction of the team, Rum was relieved on station by Hostage Pete (Lt Benson) who then controlled an air strike and artillery on the area.

Christmas Day, 25 December, was enjoyed with minimum flying.

Hostage Pete (Lt Benson) delivered smoke for the extraction of recon team Lil' Abner and Hostage Fang (Lt Yale) received fire while on a routine VR.

On 26 December, Hostage Roach (Lt Davidson) called artillery on personnel in a bunker complex. Roach reported a BDA of two bunkers destroyed and two probable KIA.

Twenty-seven and twenty-eight December passed with out significant events.

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On 29 December, Hostage Farmer (Lt Parker) delivered smoke for a troop insert.

Hostage Six (LtCol Janz) controlled two air strikes for a recon team in contact on 30 December. No BDA was reported.

Hostage Fang (Lt Yale) was diverted from a VR of the TACR to cover an emergency medevac.

The month ended with Hostage Bravo (Capt Sabia) providing cover for a downed helicopter. No contact was reported and the helicopter and personnel were lifted safely out of the site that afternoon.
