PART II -- SIGNIFICANT HIGHLIGHTS

1. (C) Early in November ASRT Alpha at Dong Ha moved to Da Nang. The move was accomplished by equipment trade with MASS 2.

The squadron provided training, administrative, and supply assistance to ASRT Charlie (MASS 3 Alpha) at Da Nang, and at the end of the month training of strike controllers and operators was nearly completed.

At Chu Lai both the DASC and the ASRT experienced sharp increases in fixed wing missions conducted in support of III MAF units with the tempo of operations nearly double last month's. The problem of faulty ASRT electronic tubes reported last month has been alleviated.

2. (U) Civic Action. During the month the squadron MEDCAP team treated 203 adults and 1144 children. Two pneumonia cases and one case of infectious pulmonary tuberculosis were treated and cured. Material for well construction was provided and work on the Trung Toan dispensary continued. Two local chiefs were invited to a ceremony and dinner in the squadron area in observance of the Marine Corps birthday on 10 November. General Walt scholarships were awarded to several local children, and the usual Sunday afternoon childrens' recreation periods were held in the MASS 3 recreation hut. Movies, games, and refreshments were provided.
