PART II - STONIFICANT HIGHLIGHTS

1. (C) The squadron continued to operate DASC's and ASRT's at Chu Lai and Da Nang in support of INI MAC units.

As the end of the month neared and the effects of the northeast monseem began to intensify, a gradual increase in daytime TEQ-10 activity began.

MASS 3 direct air support centers controlled 8,639 fixed-wing and 13,921 helicopter missions during 1967. MASS 3 air emport rader teams, controlled 8,054 bembing missions, hibting 14,330 targets with 19,732 tons of crunance during 1967.

- 2. (C) Training. Four new officers who joined the squadron late in Nagember completed qualification as TPQ-10 strike controllers and as DASC senior air directors. Two officers from MACS 6 reported on 23 December for 20 days TAD in connection with OJT as strike controllers and senior air directors.
- 3. (U) Civic action. The squadron MEDCAP team treated 147 adults and 841 children. Three persons were taken to 1st Hospital Company for further treatment. The team also distributed 352 bars of soap.
