PART II - SIGNIFICANT HIGHLIGHTS

(C) During the month of June MASS-3 units continued to support III MAF operations in ICTZ. In the Da Nang area there was a decrease in fixed wing missions flown while an increase was shown for the Khe Sanh area. The increased tempo of operations in the northwest area of ICTZ was due in part to preparations for the planned move of Task Force Hotel Headquarters from Khe Sanh to Landing Zone Stud near Ca Lu, RVN. On 24 June Khe Sanh ASRT Alfa was moved from Khe Sanh to Chu Lai in response to movement orders where it was re-designated Chu Lai ASRT Alfa. The team and equipment departed by helicopter the morning of the 24th for Dong Ha, RVN. The team and equipment arrived by fixed wing transport in Chu Lai the afternoon of the same day where the system was installed and became operational with a successful calibration flight completed the morning of 29 June. The antenna group of this radar (system A-77) suffered several shrapnel hits while at Khe Sanh with three holes of one to two inches through the parabolic reflector resulting in a reduction of its ability to maintain lock at distances over 20 miles. A new antenna has been ordered.

The Khe Sanh DASC was de-activated on 27 June for the move to Landing Zone Stud about eight miles east of Khe Sanh. The move was accomplished by truck convoy on route 9 and the DASC was operational again on the morning of the 29th. The DASC is now located with Task Force Hotel Headquarters at LZ Stud in the FSCC bunker.

4. (U) Civic Action. MASS-3 Medcap treated 72 adults and 207 children. The Civic Action Officer met with Trung Toan Hamlet Officials to plan the construction of a public shower. 19 bags of cement were delivered to the hamlet chief for the start of the project. 130 children of Trung Toan and Sam Hai hamlets were taken to Chu Lai beach for recreation and refreshments. 12 students of Trung Toan and Sam Hai hamlets are being supported by the General Walt Scholarship.
