PART II - SIGNIFICANT HIGHLIGHTS

(C) In July MASS-3 units deployed throughout I Corps Tactical Zone continued to support III MAF Operations. In the north Vandergrift DASC (formerly Stud DASC) showed a marked increase in helicopter activity, due in part to an increasing utilization of helicopters for tactical troop movements. In the Da Nang area the helicopter mission totals also increased over June's figures with a substantial gain in Med-Evac missions. The two air support radar teams in Da Nang maintained generally the same tempo of operations as in June with one significant difference. The ratio of targets hit per TPQ mission increased by 38% from 1.40 targets hit per mission to 1.93.

In Chu Lai ASRT ALFA (system A-17) which had been transferred from Khe Sanh on 24 June began to present serious tracking problems. The fiberglass radome had received a number of shrapnel hits while at Khe Sanh and was no longer weather proof allowing moisture to collect between the layers of fiberglass material. In addition the parabolic reflector had three holes of one to two inches made by fragments penetrating from the rear with consequent distortion of the reflecting surface. The antenna was removed from the system and disassembled. The holes in the reflector were smoothed and covered with heavy aluminum foil and MAG-12 provided the fiberglass repair for the radome. The antenna was then assembled, mounted and aligned successfully with excellent tracking results. It is believed that the above described field expedient in lieu of fifth echelon repair will allow the radar to remain in operation until the new antenna ordered in June arrives.
