PART II: NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. During the month of January, flight operations were limited by the seasonal wet monsoon. Low ceilings and poor visibility were the rule for the better part of the month. Operations in the Phu Bai and "Chinook" TAOR'S were supported with four gunships and six slicks located at Phu-Bai. Operation "Prairie" was supported with two slicks located at Dong Ha. Operation "Deckhouse V" was supported by the Special Landing Force detachment with two gunships and two slicks located aboard the USS Iwo Jima (LPH-2).

1-7 Jan 1967: Squadron conducted no flight operations. Eight slicks were enroute to Vietnam aboard the USNS CROTAN. Two gunships and two slicks were located aboard the USS Iwo Jima (LPH-2), and the operations of this detachment will be given separately. Pilots from this squadron flew as co-pilots with HMM-163, VMO-2, and VMO-6 for area checkouts.

8 Jan 1967: Flew eight slicks from the USNS CROTAN to the Marble Mountain Air Facility.

10 Jan 1967: Flew eight slicks from the Marble Mountain Air Facility to the Hue/Phu Bai Airport.

11-15 Jan 1967: Flew fam hops in the local traffic pattern at Phu Bai.

16 Jan 1967: Squadron became operational. Dispatched two slicks to Dong Ha. Flew one command and coordination mission at Phu Bai. The Dong Ha detachment had one slick fly construction workers and inspectors to a coastal refueling point at YD 335691, and another slick for an over fly of the Dong Ha TAOR.

17 Jan 1967: Flew one administrative hop to Marble Mountain Air Facility. One slick flew a visual recon of the Da Nang TAOR. One slick flew the Commanding General, 3rd Marine Division to Dong Ha and back to Phu Bai. Flew two visual recon missions of the "Chinook" TAOR in support of the 3rd Battalion, 26th Marine Regiment.

18 Jan 1967: Flew one administrative mission to Marble Mountain Air Facility. The Dong Ha detachment flew five VIP missions. Brigadier General RYAN was flown to the Cam Lo area and then brought back to Dong Ha. Army Lieutenant General WEST was flown to Gio Linh, the Rockpile and back to Dong Ha. He was then flown to the I Corps landing zone at Da Nang. Also, a Marine VIP code 7 was flown to YD 164402 and returned to Dong Ha.

19 Jan 1967: The Special Landing Force detachment flew the two gunships and two slicks from Marble Mountain Air Facility to Phu Bai. The Commanding General, 3rd Marine Division, was flown to Dong Ha and back to Phu Bai. The Dong Ha detachment flew Brigadier General RYAN to YD 064544 and returned him to Dong Ha. Lieutenant Colonel MASTERPOOL was flown to YD 116701 and back to Dong Ha. They also flew an observation and correction mission for TPQ bombing calibration at YD 951599.

20 Jan 1967: Viet Cong Mortar attack of Phu Bai airfield at 0140. One slick and one gunship lunched at 0300 and 0420 respectively for a visual recon of the south eastern sector of the Phu Bai TAOR. Two gunships were launched at 0700 for a recon of the area where the mortar fire came from. There was no contact with the enemy. One slick flew one VIP mission and one courier mission to the hospital ship REPOSE. The Dong Ha detachment flew the following missions: One slick carried a VIP from YD 245596 to Dong Ha; One slick was escort for a motorized convoy from Dong Ha to the "Chinook" Logistic Supply Area, and then flew the Commanding Officer, 4th Marine Regiment to Dong Ha; Brigadier General RYAN was flown to Ba Long for an awards ceremony; and Lieutenant Colonel MASTERPOOL was flown to YD 299580 for a visual recon.

21 Jan 1967: All scheduled missions at Phu Bai were held due to bad weather. One gunship flew five missions as armed escort in support of HMM-163 on emergency medical evacuations at the following coordinates: ZD 139009, YD 504257, YD 995005, YD 895235, and YD 985005. No fire was received. The Dong Ha detachment flew a Marine VIP code 7 to the Hue Citadel, the "Chinook" ISA and returned him to Dong Ha. One slick flew a visual recon for a future landing zone at YD 116701. Brigadier General RYAN was flown to YD 980570. A visual recon at YD 210740 was flown in support of the ARVN'S. A Marine VIP code 7 was flown from landing zone Eagle (YD 064544) to Dong Ha.

22 Jan 1967: Flew medevac escort for HMM-163 during medevacs at YD 440544, YD 552276, and YD 398582. The Dong Ha detachment flew three VIP missions with Brigadier General RYAN in support of Operation "Hawk".

23 Jan 1967: Flew armed escort missions as medevac chase for HMM-163 to the following coordinates: YD 577337, YD 546264, YD 630430, BT 059732, and YD 538320. At YD 545266 sniper fire was being received and two gunships were used to deliver suppressive fire. No damage assessment was available. The Dong Ha detachment flew three VIP missions.

24 Jan 1967: Flew two administrative missions to Dong Ha. Provided medevac escort for HMM-163 to the following coordinates: YD 547277, YD 548268, YD 634429, YD 343535, YD 534265, YD 545291, YD 574296, and YD 547291. One slick was flown to Dong Ha for crew relief there. Eight VIP missions were flown by the Dong Ha detachment.

25 Jan 1967: Flew one administrative hop to Marble Mountain Air Facility. Flew the Commanding Officer, 3rd Battalion, 26th Marine Regiment, to YD 532318, YD 545315, and YD 588282. Flew an overflight of the Phu Bai TAOR. One armed escort mission was flown in support of HMM-163 for a medevac at ZD 040023. The Commanding General, 3rd Marine Division, was flown to YD 532318, Dong Ha, and returned to Phu Bai. One gun ship flew a recon mission to YD 518182 to make assessment of TPQ bombing. Two gun ships flew four missions in support

of an ARVN company who had surrounded an estimated Viet Cong platoon in a village at YD 694304. They made rocket and gun runs on the village and a temple at YD 695303. The confirmed damage assessment was six structures destroyed, two automatic weapons positions destroyed, and four enemy dead. At Dong Ha there were four VIP missions and one recon mission flown in the Dong Ha TAOR.

26 Jan 1967: Four armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-163 on medevacs, two of which were without incident. The third escort took fire at the zone, delivered suppressive fire in support of the ground troops. Escorted the medevac bird to Hue/Phu Bai, then refueled and returned to YD 533325 to provide additional support. Ten missions of visual recon of the "Chinook" and Phu Bai TAOR'S were flown in support of the 2nd Battalion, 26th Marine Regiment. The Dong Ha detachment flew four VIP missions and three visual recon missions in the Khe Sanh, Dong Ha, and Camp Carroll areas.

27 Jan 1967: One gun ship escorted the Sparrow Hawk to YD 479264, and expended ordnance on a large group of Viet Cong at YD 470260. Small arms fire was received upon leaving the area. A visual recon mission with landings at ZD 097007, ZD 201011, ZD 139008, and ZD 041023, was flown in support of the 3rd Marine Division. Two passengers were flown to YD 245596. One visual recon mission of the Phu Bai TAOR was flown. Four armed escort missions were flown in support of a helicopter insertion of troops at YD 460270. The Commanding General, 3rd Marine Division, was flown to Dong Ha, Khe Sanh, Dong Ha, and brought back to Phu Bai. Four VIP missions were flown by the Dong Ha detachment.

28 Jan 1967: The Commanding General, 3rd Marine Division, was flown to the Operation "Chinook" LSA, Quang Tri, and returned to Phu Bai. One visual recon mission of the "Chinook" TAOR was flown. One TAC(A) mission was flown in support of a fixed wing strike at YD 564253. One slick was fired on during a TAC(A) mission with an Aerial Observer aboard while making a marking run at YD 591271 in support of a fixed wing strike. Two gunships were used as armed escort in support of a troop extraction at YD 475261. Flew one visual recon mission of Recon Zones II, III, and IV in the Phu Bai TAOR. A visual recon mission was flown in support of the 2nd Battalion, 9th Marine Regiment. The 3rd Battalion, 26th Marine Regiment, was supported with a visual recon of the "Chinook" TAOR. Two armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-163 for medevacs at YD 337532 and YD 997007. One VIP mission was flown to YD 095680, YD 340700, and back to Dong Ha. The Dong Ha detachment also flew three other VIP missions: an Air Force photographer was flown to YD 245605; the Commanding Officer, Marine Air Group 16, was flown to YD 665527 to inspect three downed helicopters; and Brigadier General RYAN was flown to YD 340530, Quang Tri, and back to Dong Ha.

29 Jan 1967: Flew three missions as armed escort for HMM-163 on medevacs at YD 871065, YD 579281, and ZD 997135. No fire was received. One visual recon mission of the "Chinook" TAOR was flown in support of the 3rd Battalion, 26th Marine Regiment. Flew one recon mission of the Phu Bai TAOR in support of the 2nd Battalion, 9th Marine Regiment. The Chief of Staff of the 3rd Marine Division was flown to the "Chinook" ISA, Dong Ha, and brought back to Phu Bai. Two gunships flew armed escort in support of HMM-163 for the insertion of recon teams at YD 781060, YD 903994, YD 460252, and YD 598234, and the extraction of teams at YD 464252, YD 705116, and YD 886031. No fire was received on these missions.

30 Jan 1967: Flew two missions as armed escort for HMM-163 on emergency medevacs at YD 280463 and YD 543285. The Commanding General, 3rd Marine Division, and an Army VIP code 4 were flown to Dong Ha for a recon of the DMZ and the Rockpile area. Flew one recon mission of the "Chinook" TAOR with a gunship escort in support of the 3rd Battalion, 26th Marine Regiment. A recon overfly of YD 8034 was flown with an armed escort in support of the 2nd Battalion, 9th Marine Regiment. The Dong Ha detachment transported passengers to the 12th Marine Regiment's position, (YD 148650), and back to Dong Ha. The Commanding Officer, 4th Marine Regiment, was flown for a beach recon in the Dong Ha area.

31 Jan 1967: Three armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-163 on medevacs to YC 913994 and ZD 195009. One administrative mission was flown to the Marble Mountain Air Facility. The Dong Ha detachment flew Brigadier General RYAN to Quang Tri and back to Dong Ha.

3 Jan 1967: The Executive Officer of the SLF was flown to Washtenau, Caronino, and returned to the USS Iwo Jima. COMPHIB was flown to the "Deckhouse V" operation area for an aerial recon.

4 Jan 1967: The Commanding General of the Vietnamese Marine Corps was flown to Bien Hoa. Six mission's of visual recon were flown in the Deckhouse V" operating area. Three other mission's were flown carrying passengers between the USS Iwo Jima and landing zones on the beach.

5 Jan 1967: Seven sorties were flown carrying passengers from the Iwo Jima to other ships in the SLF. A Marine VIP code Seven was flown to Ton Son Nhut.

6 Jan 1967: Two recon mission's were flown for Grey Rebel 14A. Two gunships flew as armed escort to Kom Giong Chua. Sixteen armed helicopter Mission's were flown in support of HMM-363 during troop lifts at landing zones Crow and Duck. Four pamphlet drop mission's four VIP mission's and eight recon missions were flown in the "Deckhouse V" operating area. A photographer was flown to White Beach (XR 765848) for coverage of a strike there. Two artillery registration missions were flown in support of the Battalion Landing Team FSCC, and seven VIP missions were flown carrying Brigadier General METZGER to and from landing zone SPARROW. Two recon missions were also flown over the Red Beach area. One registration mission was flown for naval gunfire in grid square XR 8191. Brigadier General METZGER and the SLF Commander were flown to landing zone Duck to observe L hour, and a Navy VIP code 5 was flown to Boundary Tango.

7 Jan 1967: One armed escort mission was flown to landing zone Crow. 32 sorties of armed escort were flown in support of troop lifts, during which suppressive fire was delivered in the landing zones. One armed escort mission was flown for a visual recon of the "Deckhouse V" operating area. Eight sorties were flown carrying passengers, along with two recon missions of landing zones Duck, Crow, and Red Beach. Brigadier General METZGER and the Commanding Officer of Carrier Task Group 79.5 was flown to landing zones Duck for a visual recon and then to landing zone Crow to observe a troop lift.

8 Jan 1967: 46 Sorties were flown carrying passengers. Five recon mission's were flown of Red Beach and landing zone Eagle. Two missions were flown conducting artillery registrations at XS 788948. The SLF detachment also flew one propaganda leaflet drop mission, and 11 armed escort mission in support of troop lifts to landing zone Hawk, where suppressive fire was delivered.

9 Jan 1967: The SLF detachment flew 62 sorties carrying passengers. Ten sorties of armed escort were flown in support of troop lifts, and fire was delivered on Viet Cong positions from which mortar and small arms fire had been received.

10 Jan 1967: 14 sorties were flown carrying passengers, which included Commander Gleen Ford and Admiral Walzen. 24 sorties were also flown taking the Commanding Officer of the SLF and his party between the USS Iwo Jima, White Beach, Red Beach, and Thanh Phu.

11 Jan 1967: One medical evacuation mission was flown. Six VIP sorties were flown, during which General Westmoreland and his party were taken to Red Beach. Two recon and two armed escort missions were flown in the RACH EOLOL River Area. Seven recon missions were flown of grid squares XR 8189, XR 8190, XR 8193, XR 8194, and XR 8293. The SLF detachment flew 11 armed escort missions during which fire was delivered on suspected enemy positions in sector Purple and four camouflaged ships at XR 783914. Eight sorties were also flown carrying passengers.

12 Jan 1967: The SLF detachment flew 38 sorties carrying passengers between the USS Iwo Jima, Red Beach, and White Beach. 13 sorties of armed escort were flown in support of troop lifts, during which suppressive fire was delivered. Suppressive fire was also delivered on 20 armed escort sorties in support of HMM-362 and HMM-164 for troop lifts to XR 769935, XR 787927, XR 786963, XR 787953, landing zone Crow, XR 783924, XR 790914, and XR 819922. Four recon sorties were also flown, along with 20 sorties of armed escort and administration/liaison in support of a troop lift to XR 751001.

13 Jan 1967: The SLF detachment flew 27 sorties of armed escort in support of HMM-362 during troop lifts, and 14 sorties carrying the Commanding Officer Task Group 79.5.

14 Jan 1967: 19 administration/liaison sorties were flown, and 26 sorties of armed escort in support of troop lifts and resupply drops.

15 Jan 1967: The SLF detachment flew 39 administration/liaison sorties in the "Deckhouse V" operating area. 32,750 rounds of 7.62 mm ammunition and 232 2.75" rockets were expended while delivering suppressive fire on armed escort mission's.

PART III: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. Personnel

a. Promotions. Two personnel were promoted to First Lieutenant; one to Gunnery Sergeant, ten to Corporal and two to PFC.

b. One officer was joined, one officer was transferred; seven enlisted were transferred, and 15 enlisted were joined.

2. Administration

a. No change of command within the Squadron.

b. No outstanding administrative problem.

3. Awards: One purple Heart, and one Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal.

4. Casualties; Capt Rodney H. ALLEY Jr 076581/USMC; Date 14Jan67; Place, Qua Nam Hoa District, South West Ban Bo River (YD 565194). Special circumstances; Co-pilot in VMO-6 UH1E flying armed support; struck by enemy fire.

5. Civic Action 12-4.8 cubic feet wooden boxes, containing clothing were delivered to the 3rd Marine Division Chaplain to be used by the Saint Paul de Chavez Orphanage Home in Hue.

8. Intelligence/Counter-Intelligence.

a. During the month of Jan67, this squadron was given an Intelligence Brief by the Group Intelligence Officer. This was the initial country brief for the Squadron.

b. Squadron S-2 has conducted pre-flight briefings and bi-weekly situation briefings for the pilots and SNCO's, and all Crew Members.

c. Liaison was established with 3rd Division G-2, Division Air Officer, and with HMM-163 regarding items of mutual intelligence interest.

d. All personnel of this squadron were briefed regarding their personal conduct in Vietnam and in dealings with Vietnamese Nationals. Also covered was personal censorship, photography of military installations, and reporting information of intelligence value.

11. Special Operations. "Prairie", "Chinook", and "Deckhouse V".

15. Training

a. General Military Subjects Training. Consisted of a NCO leadership group study, utilizing Marine Corps Institute lesson plans, texts, and tests. All E5's and below in the Squadron were enrolled, and classes were held five nights a week.

b. Technical Training. Conducted by the individual departments through on the Job Training. Continued emphasis has been placed on the use of correspondence courses to help each Marine advance in rank in his particular MOS.

c. Pilot Training. Continuous as more combat flying experience was gained by the pilots of this squadron. A minimum of two "All Pilot's Meetings" were held each week. The Pilots not qualified in model were scheduled for missions which would help them advance in the NATOP's syllabus training. A class was held for the pilots by MATCU-68 on instrument flight rules procedures in the local flying areas.

d. Crew Chief and Gunner Training. Being continually conducted through experience and practical application in map reading, spotting and marking enemy fire, delivering fire on enemy targets, marking landing zones with smoke grenades, and arming and dearming the rockets and fixed guns. All crew chiefs and gunners were given instructions on the use of the "Camera Still Picture Type KE-28B", which is being utilized in this Squadron with great effect.

17. Supply

a. One Navy clerk E1/3071 has been sent to MAG-16 as Expeditor and we have received one E1/3071 and one E2/3051. All Navy publications have been received or are requisitioned.

b. The Marine Corps Property Warehouse has been completed and ready for issue since 15Jan67. The supply section is in the process of invoicing Marine Corps accountable property to MAG-16.

c. A fiscal grant for project "01" of \$33,800. has been received from 1stMAW.

d. Approximately 160,000 pounds of gear were off-loaded at the Hue ramp from LCU's and moved by truck to Phu Bai. Our squadron did not have enough organic motor transport for this type of operation, therefore we had to arrange for transportation from other activities.

18. Motor Transport. 12 vehicles assigned: 3-M35A2; 3-MCIA; 3-M677; 1-MC8A1; 1-M679; and 1-M49. Total miles utilized 2,148.0. Three vehicles were re-assigned to MAG-16; 1-M35A2; 1-M38A1; and 1-M676.

20. Aircraft Maintenance

a. A total of 12 UH1E aircraft are assigned. During the month, availability has averaged 67%.

b. During this period, two slicks have been operating from Dong Ha, and are rotated periodically for maintenance.

c. Overall aircraft maintenance has been satisfactory considering the working conditions. At the present, aircraft checks are performed in an ordnance tent, but are improving the working areas constantly. There is the constant problem of sand, but a continuing program of aircraft cleaning should minimize the adverse effects from it.

21. Avionics

a. There are 26 personnel assigned. We have had 20 men available through this period.

b. The maintenance department has issued 91 work orders to date; of this number there have been 58 issued to Avionics. The more common discrepancy being the FM, (AN ARC-44). In our operations, this is the main form of communications with the Ground Forces, thus the equipment has more constant use. There has been no particular portion of equipment breakdown. Caution lights and warning lights have been another re-curring discrepancy. The combination of the rain and mud, and then the dry sand have been a problem in lights, circuit breakers, and cannon plugs.

c. Supply of equipment has steadily improved and has cut the down time of aircraft greatly. There has been a need for cannibalization but it is a decreasing problem.

d. Training of shop personnel has been limited to "On the job type". As the menial tasks of the area decrease there will be more opportunity for formal technical training.
