PART II NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. The weather during the month of June was excellent for flight operations. Clear skies with occasional afternoon and evening thunderstorms was the weather picture during this time. Operations in the Phu Bai, Choctaw and Crockett TAOR's were supported with nine gunships and six slicks at Phu Bai and two gunships at Khe Sanh.

1 JUNE 1967: 11 armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-163 during medevacs. Ten armed escort missions were flown during recon team inserts and extracts. One armed escort mission was flown providing support for an ARVN ground unit, during which nine structures were destroyed. Two VIP missions were flown carrying the CG, 3rd MARDIV. Two VIP missions were flown carrying BGen METZGER, along with three admin/liaison missions, one medevac, and one visual recon mission. The Khe Sanh detachment flew two armed escort missions in support of Operation "CROCKETT".

2 JUNE 1967: Six armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-163 during medevacs. Two TAC (A) missions were flown during landing zone preps. 





**15. Training**

a. Technical Training. 7,944.7 hours of on the job training were accomplished, and 1148.7 hours of formal classes were given.

b. Pilot/Aircrew Training. With the arrival of the second increment in-country an increase in training was required. Squadron Order 3510.1 was published to set forth an SOP for training Pilots/Aircrewmen new in-country.

(1) A Pilot Training Bulletin is published monthly. At each APM a Pilot Training Lecture is also given. NATOPS "spot Checks" are given to each new pilot on each type of mission flown by this Squadron.

(2) An Aircrew Training Schedule is published monthly. Training is conducted on a daily basis with five to seven men scheduled at a time. The training includes lectures and practical applications of duties as Aircrewmen. The lectures are as follows:



(2) The Squadron Materiel Section and Marine Corps Property Section, including officer and warehouse space, were moved from the old to the new location on the flight line.

(3) A complete inventory of Navy Property is underway and should be completed by 15 July 1967. This includes a complete new set of custody cards as per allowance changes in the new IMRL.

b. Marine Corps Property Section:

(1) All items of individuals equipment were invoiced to MAG-16 Group Supply Forward.

(2) All items of clothing for the in-kind issue system were turned over.

20. Aircraft Maintenance.

a. Aircraft availability for the month of June averaged 66.5%. This represents an increase of 2.5% over May. At the present time, we have four (4) aircraft AOCF for Main Rotor Hub Assemblies. The problem encountered doesn't seem to be environmental at this time, but rather design deficiency. This assumption is based on the fact that each of the 4 hub assemblies were found to have cracked extension sleeves during the first 180 hour hub inspection.

b. We are still operating without any semblance of a hanger for aircraft maintenance work, as we have for the past 6 months. We are hoping this will be corrected before the onset of inclement weather, in order to properly perform required maintenance that must be done day and night.

c. We received four new aircraft plus two from rework at H&MS-16.

21. Avionics.

a. In June we transferred twenty two avionics personnel. This brings the shop strength back to twenty six.

b. The workload has remained the same as previous months with the FM (ARC-44) as the most problem. The Tacan (ARN-52) is still the high priority item due to the shortage in supply.

c. There have been nine Ground Fire Detector Kits installed on our aircraft. This was accomplished with Mr. SANCTUARY of Delmar Engineering Laboratories supervising, (Los Angeles, California).
