

Operations in the Phu Bai, Freemont and Ardmore TAOR's were supported with 13 gunships and six slicks at Phu Bai two gunships at Khe Sanh and 3 at Dong Ha.





b. The Photo Section gave almost exclusive support to 3rd Recon Bn with 38 fragged photo missions. This was a 110% increase over the previous month. 81 landing zones were photographed.

d. Fire incidents for the squadron amounted to 42 fire incidents, of which 12 were hits.

a. General Military Subject Training. Five hours of classes were given to 12 newly joined personnel, which consisted of Intelligence brief, general area brief and weapons indoctrination brief.

b. Technical Training. 9,774.0 hours of on-the-job training were accomplished, and 277.5 hours of formal classes were given.

c. Pilot Training. Two pilots re-qualified on NATOPS, two pilots renewal on standard instrument cards and on the three newly joined pilots all lectures as prescribed by our squadron SOP 3510.1, "Pilot In-Country Training". Our TAC (A) syllabus is progressing; qualifying pilots as prescribed in our Training SOP.

d. Crew Chief, Gunner and Photo Training. Three crew chiefs were NATOPS qualified and eight aerial gunners were NATOPS qualified. Photo Training is progressing along with a total of four enlisted men qualified. Emphasis at the present time is put on photo briefings to all pilots and crew members.

e. Education. For the month of July this squadron has 71 personnel enrolled in 107 correspondence courses.

17. Supply

a. During the month of July 1967, this command obligated and spent \$16,223.56 of Project 01 funds.

b. An administrative inspection was held during this period on both the Navy and Marine Corps Property Sections, with satisfactory results.

c. During this period a relief of Material and Marine Corps Property Officers was held. Inventory of the Marine Corps Property section has been completed.

20. Aircraft Maintenance

a. A/C availability for the month of July 1967 averaged 73%. We now have a total of 26 A/C assigned, with 24 on hand and two at overhaul.

b. We implemented 3M system the first of the month without too much confusion since the majority of the personnel have worked under the system in the States. We now have a newly-assigned 3M analyst, so there should be a continuing improvement in documentation. The best aid to smooth operation of the system would be a communication system, which we have been told will be arriving in the near future.

21. Avionics

a. During the month of July, avionics started to operate under the 3M system.

b. After one month under the system, the system seems to be functioning adequately. An improvement in the overall operation of this system should be seen when the material section comes fully under the 3M system.

c. This month it was also noticed that sand here at Phu Bai is starting to take its toll of the electrical and electronics systems. This has principally been noticed in the operation of the UHF (ARC-52) control boxes. The sand is fouling the contacts of the preset pegs. Constant cleaning of the boxes must be accomplished in order to insure full communication capabilities.
