PART II NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. The weather for the month of September was generally good for flight operations. There were several days when flight operations were curtailed because of rain showers and fog, and the Khe Sanh detachment was prevented from flying by the weather numerous times, but generally the tempo of operations was not adversely affected by the weather.

1 Sept 1967: Eight armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-163 during medevac operations. Two of these were in support of operation Fremont. Two armed escort missions were flown during recon team inserts. Sixteen visual recon missions and one VIP mission with the CG of the third MarDiv were flown in the Phu Bai TAOR. The recon team inserts were in support of operation Cumberland. Eight armed escort missions, six in support of medevac operations and two in support of recon inserts, plus eight visual recon missions were all flown in the Dong Ha TAOR. The Khe Sanh detachment flew four visual recon missions and two armed escort missions during a recon team insert in the operation Ardmore area.

2 Sept 1967: Four armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-163 during medevac operations. Two armed escort missions were flown in support of a recon team extraction in the operation Cumberland area. Thirteen visual recon missions were flown, two of them in the operation Cumberland area. Six VIP missions were flown, three of which carried BGen METZGER. In the Dong Ha TAOR the squadron flew twelve armed escort missions and one visual recon mission. Ten of the armed escort missions were in support of medevac operations and two were in support of resupply operation. The Khe Sanh detachment flew eight armed escort missions in support of recon team operations. Their support resulted in seven enemy KIAs (confirmed) on one of these missions.

3 Sept 1967: Fifteen armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-163 during medevac operations. Two of these were in the operation Fremont area and one was in the operation Cumberland area. Eighteen visual recon missions, one TACA mission, five VIP missions, one with MGen HOCKMUTH and one with BGen METZGER, were flown in the Phu Bai operational area. In the Dong Ha operational area three armed escort and eight visual recon missions were flown, all in the operation Kingfisher area. The Khe Sanh Detachment flew

seven visual recon missions and one VIP mission in the operation Ardmore area.

4 Sept 1967: Three armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-163 during medevac operations. Fifteen visual recon missions, two of them in the operation Fremont area and one in the operation Cumberland area, plus three VIP missions were flown in the Phu Bai operational area. In the Dong Ha operational area the squadron flew seven armed escort missions supporting resupply and medevac operations. Seven visual recon missions were also flown in this area. The Khe Sanh detachment flew four visual recon missions, two medevac missions, one TACA mission, and one armed escort mission in the operation Ardmore area.

5 Sept 1967: Fourteen armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-163 during medevac operations, eight of these in the operation Fremont area. Four armed escort missions were flown in support of recon team inserts. One medevac, seventeen visual recon missions, and the one VIP mission with the CG of the third MarDiv were flown in the Phu Bai operational area. In the Dong Ha operational area, eight armed escort missions were flown in support of recon inserts and extracts. Four visual recon missions and two VIP missions with BGen METZGER aboard were also flown. Eight of these missions were in the operation Fremont area. The remainder were in the operation Kingfisher area. The Khe Sanh detachment flew two visual recon missions, two armed escort missions, and two TACA missions in the operation Ardmore area.

6 Sept 1967: Eight armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-362 during medevac operations. Twelve armed escort missions were flown in support of recon inserts and extracts in the operation Fremont and Cumberland areas. Ten visual recon missions, three in the operation Fremont area, and five VIP missions, two carrying MGen HOCKMUTH, were flown in the Phu Bai operational

area. In the Dong Ha operational area, six armed escort missions in support of recon extracts and four visual recon missions were flown in the operation Kingfisher area.

7 Sept 1967: Six armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-362 during medevac operations. Three of these were in the operation Fremont area. Eight visual recon missions, two photo missions, nine VIP missions with MGen HOCKMUTH, MGen ANDERSEN, Adm BARTLETT and BGen METZGER aboard, plus two medevacs were flown in the Phu Bai operational area. The VIP missions were flown into the Fremont, Kingfisher, and Ardmore operational areas. In the Dong Ha operational area twenty six armed escort missions were flown in support of medevac, resupply and recon team operations, plus two visual recon missions. All of these were in support of operation Kingfisher. The Khe Sanh detachment flew ten visual recon missions, two armed escort missions during recon team inserts, and two TACA missions in the operation Ardmore area.

8 Sept 1967: Sixteen armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-362 during medevac operations, all in the operation Fremont area. One TACA, two visual recon, two medevacs, and three VIP missions were flown in the Phu Bai operational area. Sixteen armed escort missions, fourteen in support of medevac operations and two in support of aircraft recovery operations plus one TACA and two visual recon missions were flown in the Dong Ha operational area. These were all flown in the operation Kingfisher area. The Khe Sanh detachment flew four visual recon missions, two TACA missions, and two armed escort missions in the operation Ardmore area.

9 Sept 1967: Three armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-362 during medevac operations. Two of these were in the operation Fremont area

and one in the operation Cumberland area. Fourteen visual recon missions, four VIP missions carrying MGen HOCKMUTH and BGen METZGER into the operation Fremont and operation Kingfisher areas, and one resupply mission were all conducted from the base at Phu Bai. In the Dong Ha operational area four armed escort missions were flown in support of medevac operations along with two visual recon missions. All of these were in the operation Kingfisher and operation Fremont areas. The Khe Sanh detachment flew eight armed escort missions in support of recon inserts and extracts, two armed escort missions in support of medevac operations, two TACA, and four visual recon missions. All were in the operation Ardmore area.

10 Sept 1967: Four armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-362 during medevac operations. Three of these were in the operation Cumberland area. Two armed escort missions were flown in support of a recon insert in the operation Fremont area. Eight visual recon missions were flown in the Phu Bai operational area. Two of these were in the operation Cumberland area and one in the operation Fremont area. Four VIP missions were flown, one carrying MGen HOCKMUTH, and one carrying BGen METZGER. The Khe Sanh detachment flew four visual recon missions in the operation Ardmore area. In the Dong Ha operational area ten visual recon missions, twelve armed escort missions in support of medevacs and resupply operations, one VIP mission, and one medevac were all flown in support of operation Kingfisher.

11 Sept 1967: One armed escort mission was flown in support of HMM-362 during a recon insert. Seven visual recon missions, one photo mission and three VIP missions carrying MGen HOCKMUTH were all flown in the Phu Bai operational area. In the Dong Ha operational area eight armed escort missions and two visual recon missions were flown in the operation Kingfisher area. The Khe

Sanh detachment flew four visual recon missions and four armed escort missions during recon team extractions, in the operation Ardmore area.

12 Sept 1967: Six armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-362 during medevac operations. One medevac and eight visual recon missions were conducted in the operation Fremont area. Seven VIP missions carrying Adm BARTLETT and MGen BOUCHER were flown in the Phu Bai operational area. In the Dong Ha operational area four armed escort missions in support of medevacs and resupply operations, and six visual recon missions were flown in the operation Kingfisher area. The Khe Sanh detachment flew two visual recon missions and six armed escort missions during medevacs and recon inserts and extracts. All of these missions were in the operation Ardmore area.

13 Sept 1967: In the Phu Bai operational area two armed escort missions were flown during convoy operations. Six visual recon missions, one photo mission, and two VIP missions carrying MGen HOCKMUTH were also flown. In the Dong Ha operational area eight visual recon missions and one TAC (A) mission were flown in the operation Kingfisher area. The Khe Sanh detachment flew four visual recon missions, and two armed escort missions during a recon extract. All were in the operation Ardmore area.

14 Sept 1967: Sixteen armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-362 during medevac, recon inserts and extracts, and troop lift operations. Four visual recon missions, three troop lift operations and four VIP missions carrying BGen METZGER were all flown in the Phu Bai operational area. In the Dong Ha operational area four armed escort missions were flown in support of convoy operations, in the operation Kingfisher area. The Khe Sanh detachment flew one TAC (A) mission, two armed escort missions in support of resupply and two visual recon mission in the operation Ardmore area.

15 Sept 1967: Seven armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-362

during medevac operations. Four armed escort missions were flown in support of a troop lift and six armed escort missions were flown in the operation Fremont and operation Cumberland areas during recon inserts and extracts.

Six visual recon missions, six medevac missions and five VIP missions were flown in the Phu Bai operational area. In the Dong Ha area of operations two visual recon missions were flown into the operation Kingfisher area.

The Khe Sanh detachment flew four visual recon missions and one TAC (A) mission in the operation Ardmore area.

16 Sept 1967: Two armed escort missions were flown in support of recon team inserts. Ten visual recon missions and two VIP missions were flown in the Phu Bai operational area. The Khe Sanh detachment flew two armed escort missions in support of a recon team extract in the operation Ardmore area.

17 Sept 1967: Two armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-362 during medevac operations. Six armed escort missions were flown in support of recon inserts and extracts, and six visual recon missions plus one VIP mission were flown in the Phu Bai operational area. In the Dong Ha operational area four armed escort missions were flown in support of resupply operations in the operation Kingfisher area.

18 Sept 1967: Five armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-362 during medevac operations. Four armed escort missions were flown in support of recon inserts and extracts. Thirteen visual recon missions and four VIP missions carrying MGen HOCKMUTH and BGen METZGER into the operation Kingfisher area were flown from the squadron base at Phu Bai. In the Dong Ha operational area eight armed escort missions were flown, two in support of medevac operations, two in support of a recon extract and four in support

19 Sept 1967: Three armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-362 during medevacs operations. Four armed escort missions were flown in support of recon inserts and extracts. Two admin liaison missions, one photo recon mission, eight visual recon missions and four VIP missions carrying MGen HOCKMUTH and BGen METZGER were flown in the Phu Bai operational area. In the Dong Ha operational area seventeen armed escort missions were flown. Seven were in support of resupply operations, six in support of medevac operations and four in support of recon extracts. All were in the operation Kingfisher area.

20 Sept 1967: Three armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-362 during medevac operations. Two armed escort missions were flown during a recon insert, four VIP missions carrying MGen HOCKMUTH and BGen METZGER and fifteen visual recon missions were all flown in the Phu Bai operational area. In the Dong Ha operational area two armed escort missions in support of convoy operations and two visual recon missions in the operation Kingfisher area were flown. The Khe Sanh detachment flew six visual recon missions in the operation Ardmore area.

21 Sept 1967: Three armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-362 during medevac operations. Two of these were in the operation Fremont area. Five VIP missions carrying MGen HOCKMUTH and BGen METZGER into the operation Kingfisher, Fremont and Ardmore areas, and thirteen visual recon missions were flown in the Phu Bai operational area. In the Dong Ha operational area twenty-two armed escort missions were flown, eight during medevac operations, ten during resupply operations, two during aircraft recovery operations, and two during recon extracts. Two medevac missions were also

flown. All of these were in the operation Kingfisher area. The Khe Sanh

detachment flew six visual recon missions in the operation Ardmore area.

22 Sept 1967: Five armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-362 during medevac operations. One armed escort mission was flown during resupply operations and four during recon inserts and extracts, in the Phu Bai area. Three VIP missions were flown carrying Gen WESTMORELAND, MGen HOCKMUTH, Gen CHAISSON, and BGen METZGER into the operation Kingfisher and the operation Ardmore areas. Thirteen visual recon missions and one TAC (A) mission were also flown. In the Dong Ha operational area ten armed escort missions were flown, three during medevac operations, five during resupply operations and two during a recon extract. In addition to these six visual recon missions were flown. All of the Dong Ha missions were in the operation Kingfisher area. The Khe Sanh detachment flew two visual recon missions in the operation Ardmore area.

23 Sept 1967: Two armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-362 during medevac operations. Six armed escort missions were flown during recon inserts and extracts. Seven visual recon missions, one TAC (A) mission, and one VIP mission carrying MGen HOCKMUTH, were flown in the Phu Bai operational area. In the Dong Ha operational area eight armed escort missions were flown, six during resupply operations and two during convoy escort operations. While on a convoy escort mission VT-17 (Bu No)(154753) crashed at coordinates YD 219631. The wreckage was recovered. In addition, two visual recon missions and one admin liaison mission were flown. All of the Dong Ha missions were in the operation Kingfisher area.

24 Sept 1967: Six armed escort missions were flown in support of HMM-362 during medevac operations. Four armed escort missions were flown during

11. SPECIAL OPERATIONS. "Cumberland", "Fremont", "Kingfisher", "Ardmore".

15. TRAINING

a. General Military Subjects Training. Classes were given to 3 newly joined personnel; consisted of Intelligence brief, general area brief and weapons indoctrination brief.

b. Technical Training. 2,552 hours of on-the-job-training were accomplished and 90.0 hours of formal classes were given.

c. Pilot Training. Three pilots renewed instrument cards. One newly joined pilot was given lectures as prescribed by Squadron SOP. TAC (A) syllabus training is progressing, qualifying pilots as prescribed in squadron training SOP. Inclement weather briefings were stressed at least 3 times a week at APM's.

d. Crew Chief/Gunner Training. Three crew chiefs NATOPS qualified and 11 aerial gunners were NATOPS qualified.

e. Education. 61 personnel enrolled in 96 correspondence courses.

17. SUPPLY

a. During the month of September this command has received 50 27 cubic foot boxes from MAG-16, subject boxes were constructed and turned over to the Embarkation section for Mount-out.

b. Materials for field fortification were put on order through MAG-16, completion of subject fortification is scheduled for 1 November 1967.

c. Sun glasses were received from NSC San Diego and issued to all pilots of this command.

20. Aircraft Maintenance

a. The average availability for the month of September was 68%. AACP's are continuing to hold the squadron's availability down. One aircraft that was hit with shrapnel during artillery attack on Dong Ha the 28th of August was shipped to H&MS-16 for repair. Repair is now complete, with testing underway. The other aircraft that was sent to H&MS is still undergoing repair.

b. One item that is sorely needed by this and other VMO squadrons is an engine vibration tester. This would greatly decrease the turnaround time on engine changes. It appears that there aren't enough vibration testers available to enable one to be turned in for calibration, without being without one for a month or so. The best solution of course, would be the engine test stand at H&MS to be operational, eliminating the necessity of vibration check at the squadron level after receiving an engine from H&MS.

21. Avionics
