Subj: SITREP for period 010001H to 012400H June 1968

1. Daily Operational Totals. VMO-6 flew 132 sorties, 35.0 flight hours, lifting 27 passengers but no cargo. VMO-6 escorted 10 med-evac missions and expended 51 rockets and 6,000 rounds of 7.62mm in support of 3rd Mar Div units. VMO-6 operations were not affected by weather, ground attack, etc.

2. Specific Operations. 011240H to 011915H. VMO-6 flew 60 sorties, 14.4 flight hours, lifting 2 passengers and expending 50 rockets and 6,000 rounds of 7.62mm in support of Operation SCOTLAND II.

3. Operational Highlight. 010730H to 011250H, missions 116, C and D. Seaworthy 4-1 and 2 after briefing at Quang Tri Recon Pad, prepared to insert BusStop. Due to low visibility fixed wing prep of zone was not possible. While inspecting the zone SW 4-1&2 received .50 caliber machine gun fire, and the mission was aborted.

Next was insert of Old Colonel recon team. The zone was prepped by 2 F-4's and the H-46 proceeded into zone. .30 caliber fire was received, the H-46 was hit and departed the area and the F-4's were called in on the target. The insert was aborted. The morning was capped off with four uneventful recon team extracts.

1. Daily Operational Totals. VMO-6 flew 188 sorties, 61.7 flight hours, lifting 17 passengers but no cargo. VMO-6 escorted 7 med evac missions and expended 94 rockets and 12,000 rounds of 7.62mm in support of 3rd MarDiv units. VMO-6 operations were not affected by weather, ground attack, etc.
2. Specific Operations. 300600H to 301915H. VMO-6 flew 94 sorties, 27.1 flight hours lifting 11 passengers but no cargo. Seaworthy expended 28 rockets and 4,500 rounds of 7.62mm in support of Operation SCOTLAND II.

Subj: SITREP for period 020001H to 022400H June 1968

1. Daily Operational Totals. VMO-6 flew 171 sorties, 74.1 flight hours, lifting 35 passengers but no cargo. VMO-6 escorted 10 med evac missions and expended 201 rockets and 2,400 rounds of 7.62mm in support of 3rd Mar Div units. VMO-6 operations were not affected by weather, ground attack, etc.
2. Specific Operations. 020908H to 021855H. VMO-6 flew 80 sorties, 24.7 flight hours, lifting 1 passenger and expending 80 rockets and 1,400 rounds of 7.62mm in support of Operation SCOTLAND II.
3. Operational Highlight. 020910H to 021520H, mission 106A. Today's highlight centers on a new operation south of Khe Sahn base. At 1100 a division of 4 UH-1E's led by LtCol MAAS (CO of VMO-6) launched to direct and provide cover for the 12 CH-46 aircraft of HMM-161 who were the transports for the near regimental sized troop lift. Upon rendezvous at Khe Sahn, the transports landed at Hill 558 to pick up the initial load of troops from 1st Bn 1st Marines, and proceeded to LZ Robin. When the LZ had been located, prepped and marked by the VMO-6 HUEY's, the transports were cleared in. A total of 88 sorties put 700 troops into the zone without incident. All helicopters then proceeded to LZ Camco (Stud) to begin the second phase of the trap for Mr. Charles. 500 troops of the 2nd Bn 4th Marines were transported into a zone near LZ Robin, to give a combined strength of 1200 Marines on the deck. The entire lift went smoothly due in large measure to the efforts of the "Seaworthy" aircraft in their role as on the scene command coordination and a suppressive fire platform. This lift was a model helicopter operation and an example of very well coordinated air-ground teamwork.

1. Daily Operational Totals. VMO-6 flew 153 sorties, 49.8 flight hours, lifting 20 passengers but no cargo. VMO-6 escorted 14 med evac missions and expended 143 rockets and 6,000 rounds of 7.62mm in support of 3rd Mar Div units. VMO-6 operations were not affected by weather, ground attack, etc.
2. Specific Operations. 030600H to 031955H. VMO-6 flew 68 sorties, 37.2 flight hours, lifting no passengers or cargo and expended 86 rockets and 2,000 rounds of 7.62mm in support of Operation SCOTLAND II.
3. Operational Highlight. 030600H to 031800H, mission 106. One flight of VMO-6 gunships logged an impressive total of 18.6 flight hours in support of the troops in the Khe Sanh area today. Launching at 0600 they began the day working on recon team inserts. Working in known enemy infested territory they successfully inserted Eagle Eye, Meetinghouse and Iceboat teams. After refueling they answered an emergency call from Iceboat recon team and proceeded to the area to provide suppressive fire for their emergency extract. After the extract the flight joined 2 more Seaworthy guns in support of 15 Ch-46 transports conducting a large troop lift. The guns provided gun cover for Murry 4-1 in an emergency med evac from Perspective Team "A". The aircraft took fire but were able to run the mission successfully. To end the day the HUEYS were again called upon to run another emergency extract, Meetinghouse Team, who had been put in earlier that day, was extracted safely and the birds were finally able to call it a day.

1. Daily Operational Totals. VMQ-6 flew 206 sorties, 66.1 flight hours, lifting 37 passengers but no cargo. VMQ-6 escorted 12 med evac missions and expended 98 rockets and 7,800 rounds of 7.62mm in support of 3rd Mar Div units.
2. Specific Operations. 050600H to 051915H. VMQ-6 flew 118 sorties, 41.5 flight hours, lifting 5 passengers, no cargo and expended 96 rockets and 7,000 rounds of 7.62mm in support of Operation SCOTLAND II.
3. Operational Highlight. 050600H to 051400H, mission 106. At 0600 Seaworthy 4-20 and 21 launched in support of Operation SCOTLAND II. The flight escorted Cattle Call 5-1&2 controlling an insert of recon team Coral Bush. This insert went very smooth although the weather conditions were marginal and forced the cancellation of the rest of the recon inserts. This flight also skillfully controlled large troop lifts for Smitty 14 into XD 910335, and Dixie Diner 14 from LZ Leon to XD 872340. These missions were also ran in very marginal weather, but without incidence due to the outstanding control by Seaworthy 4-20. Fingerprint 33 then called the flight to XD893245 to put fire on NVA in the open. The flight very effectively delivered 2.75 rockets and 7.62mm fire on the target, getting two confirmed KBA's from Fingerprint.

Realizing the gravity of the situation 4-5 & 6 (Night Reaction) launched on the mission immediately. At one time as darkness was upon the scene, there were 7 VMO-6 Huey guns delivering fire as directed by Jaw Breaker. The results are to be relayed at a later date.

1. Daily Operational Totals. VMO-6 flew 160 sorties, 55.1 flight hours, lifting 22 passengers but no cargo. VMO-6 expended 61 rockets and 6,000 rounds of 7.62mm in support of 3rd MarDiv units, and escorted 12 med-evac missions. VMO-6 operations were not affected by weather, ground attack, etc.

2. Specific Operations. 220555H to 221805H. VMO-6 flew 98 sorties, 45.2 flight hours, lifting 13 passengers but no cargo. VMO-6 expended 45 rockets and 5,200 rounds of 7.62mm in support of Operation SCOTLAND II.

220720H to 221935H. VMO-6 flew 18 sorties, 3.2 flight hours, lifting 2 passengers but no cargo. Seaworthy expended 16 rockets and 8,00 rounds of 7.62mm in support of Operation LANCASTER.

220720H to 221935H. VMO-6 flew 9 sorties, 3.2 flight hours, lifting no passengers or cargo, or expending no ordnance in support of Operations NAPOLEON/SALINE.

3. Operational Highlight. 220620H to 221515H, On 22 June 1968, Seaworthy 4-1 & 2 ran five missions 124, 115, 103A&B, and 106A. This was half of the missions flown by VMO-6 today. The first mission (124) was an emergency recon team insert to locate and recover a member of another team that had fallen from a hill outpost at YD 098328. The man was located, recovered and returned to the Recon Headquarters at Quang Tri.

Seaworthy 4-1&2, along with Cattle Call 5-7&8, who assisted on mission 124, proceeded on mission 115. The first insert was of team Blue Plate at XD 985423. The insert was routine and coordinated easily by the Seaworthy flight leader. No fixed wing prep was used. The second and third inserts were of the teams Garden Valley and Show Case at XD 907544 and XD 920581 respectively. Fixed wing was used on both to soften up the zone. Hellborne 511 flight was used at XD 907544 and Seaworthy 4-1 marked the zone with a white phosphorous rocket and controlled the 2 A-4s. Hellborne 512 flight was utilized in the same manner at XD 920581. The BDAs were 100/100 for both targets. The insert of Garden Valley went without incident however Cattlecall 5-7 took heavy SA/AV fire in the zone as the team was exiting.

3. (Contd)

Seaworthy 4-1 flight delivered suppressive fire on the zone. The transport returned immediately to extract the team, again with Seaworthy 4-1&2 delivering extensive suppressive fire.

The flight proceeded to extract team Corporal Pete at XD 966487 and Camp Carrol. These were routine. The flight was then diverted on mission 103A for the emergency extract of Pea Soup at XD 996613. The extract was set up by Seaworthy 4-1. Cattle Call commenced his approach for the pick-up. He began to draw fire and Seaworthy 4-1&2 immediately returned fire on the area with rockets and 7.62mm. The extract was completed successfully.

Seaworthy 4-1&2 proceeded to LZ Stud to brief for a troop lift of 290 troops for Bus Stop. Four transport helicopters were used (CattleCall 5-10-13) to insert the troops at YD 003436. No fixed wing or suppressive fire was utilized by the Seaworthy flight and the lift was completed without incident. 3.0 flight hours were flown in support of the lift, 28 sorties and there was no ordnance expended.

4. VIP Aircraft Usage. 7.5 hours flown, 3.5 hours standby.

6. Missions. Tactical missions fraged - 11. Tactical missions flown - 10. % tactical missions flown - 91%. Mission 112 was cancelled due to lack of aircraft. Mission 104 was not required by DASC.

1. Daily Operational Totals. VMO-6 flew 183 sorties, 75.5 flight hours, lifting 21 passengers but no cargo. VMO-6 expended 144 rockets, 17,000 rounds of 7.62mm in support of 3rd MarDiv units and escorted 10 med evac missions. VMO-6 operations were not affected by weather, ground attack, etc.

2. Specific Operations. 230715H to 231845H. VMO-6 flew 96 sorties, 37.6 flight hours, lifting 16 passengers but no cargo. VMO-6 expended 53 rockets and 7,000 rounds of 7.62mm in support of Operation SCOTLAND II.

230840H to 231805H. VMO-6 flew 37 sorties, 21.3 flight hours, lifting 3 passengers but no cargo. VMO-6 expended 49 rockets and 6,000 rounds of 7.62mm in support of Operation KENTUCKY.

Seaworthy 4-1 & 2 conducted 3 inserts at YD 067408, YD 027403, YD 098472. On the first two 4-1 directed Helborne 521 for LZ preps with BDAs of 75/100 and 100/100. Heavy fire was received on the second insert, however the flight was able to suppress the fire so the insert could be accomplished. The third insert was prepped by the flight and completed beautifully.

During mid-afternoon, 4-1&2 were called to Yd 159702 by a report of recon team Badminton "A" was surrounded on 3 sides. The area was prepped for 3 hours with fixed wing and gunships prior to an attempted extract. The gunships rearmed 3 times. All A/C received heavy .50 cal. fire with no hits. Seaworthy 4-2 had an engine failure (1 of 2 for the squadron today) but recovered and returned to Quang Tri. Seaworthy 4-22&23 were also in on this mission as was Seaworthy 4-5&6 (Night Reaction). As darkness started Cattle-Call 5-10&11 made the pick-up of the team. Truly a job well done by all concerned. Ordnance expended on the last extract 107 rockets and 10,800 rounds of 7.62mm.

As the two inserts met with fire from the LZ by NVA, in both cases Seaworthy was immediately available to deliver suppressive fire on the source of ground fire and cover Cattle Call as they extracted the one team on the deck which had a man hit by enemy fire.
