To complete the extraction it was necessary to obtain a flare ship, Spooky 14 and to direct the flare drop to illuminate the LZ which was located in very mountainous terrain. The Seaworthy flight leader successfully co-ordinated the flare ship and the transports while delivering his own suppressive fire and completed the extract with no aircraft hits, despite the heavy anti-aircraft and small arms fire in the area.
