The med-evac was an emergency ill for a four man recon team at XD 733417 and a complete extract of the team was requested. The team was located and covered as they moved into the LZ. The LZ was identified and Chatterbox med-evac under the cover of Seaworthy med-evac chase went in for a fast pick-up and departure. There was no fire taken or problems encountered.

This procedure places recon teams in a very dangerous position due to airstrikes used for zone preps. During the lift two recon teams, Parasol and Peasoup required a med evac which was performed by Chatterbox 6-4 with Seaworthy 4-3 in support. After Cattlecall 5-1 with Seaworthy 4-3&4 in support ran an extract of these teams from the 8927. Seaworthy 4-3&4 expended 14 rockets at 6751 as an LZ prep. Mission 402 A&B, Seaworthy 4-5&6 ran the trooplift of Coming Event I and K with Cattlecall 5-7 through 5-12 and Space 7-2 from the 7759 grid. The lift of I and K was to LZ Eagle. Seaworthy 4-5&6 proceeded to the 7962 to support the lift of Coming Event M to LZ Eagle by the same transport aircraft. Mission 201/510 was run by Seaworthy 4-7&8. Mission 201 was run in the 02-15 vertical and the 44-50 horizontal grids.
