1. Daily Operational Totals. VMO-6 flew 151 sorties, 79.8 flight hours lifting 65 passengers but no cargo. VMO-6 escorted 6 med evac missions and expended 46 rockets and 8,000 rounds of 7.62mm in support of 3rd Marine units. VMO-6 operations were not affected by weather, ground attack, etc.

2. Specific Operations. 010650 H to 011910 H. VMO-6 flew 139 sorties, 54.3 flight hours lifting 65 passengers but no cargo. Seaworthy expended 36 rockets and 8,000 rounds of 7.62mm in support of Operation LANCASTER II.

Seaworthy 4-11&12 picked up the afternoon section of 402 escorting Hurricane aircraft from LZ Winchester to C-2. Seaworthy 4-12 aircraft was RTB for mechanical reasons and Seaworthy 4-11 linked up with Scarface 6-37 to complete the mission. Mission 401, Seaworthy 4-2 flight, controlled the lift of Hasty Foot B from the 9328 to the 8926. Then the flight covered the lift of Klondike L from the 9347 to Vandegrift. VMO-6 launched its first OV's on area fam VRs today flying mission 509A,B,C. Seaworthy 2-8 on a VR for Dong Ha DASC in the YD 0576 received .50 cal, 23MM and 37MM air bursts. No known positions were found.

1. Daily Operational Totals. VMO-6 flew 101 sorties, 58.0 flight hours lifting 12 passengers but no cargo. VMO-6 escorted 4 med evac missions and expended 49 rockets and 5,200 rounds of 7.62mm in support of 3rd Marine units. VMO-6 operations were not affected by weather, ground attack, etc.

2. Specific Operations. 020630H to 021805H VMO-6 flew 60 sorties, 36.5 flight hours lifting 12 passengers but no cargo. Seaworthy expended 37 rockets and 4,700 rounds of 7.62mm in support of Operation LANG STER II.
 020648H to 021245H VMO-6 flew 3 sorties, 13.1 flight hours lifting 0 passengers but no cargo. Seaworthy expended 2 rockets and 00 rounds of 7.62mm in support of Operation SCOTLAND II.

6. Operational Highlight. Seaworthy 4-7 and flight running miss in 203, ran four inserts and extracts in the afternoon. While attempting an insert of Bannerister in the 0706 grid, the Chatterbox transport was shot out of the zone. Seaworthy 4-7 expended his flight ordnance and controlled Lovebug 309 on the target. Seaworthy 2-6 later in the day ran Helborne 203 on the same position with a HOA of 100/100 with one bunker destroyed. Seaworthy 2-5 while on a VR and SAC(A) mission in support of the 3rd MarDiv was controlling fixed wing air when he received a hit from a suspected airburst. Maj DRAAYER, first pilot of the GI-C was uninjured and WO LUKENBACH received minor facial scratches. The metal fragment remained in the rear cockpit and is under analysis by S-2. VMO-6's newest addition, the OV-10A flew two VR missions as area fan hops.

1. Daily Operational Totals. VMO-6 flew 226 sorties, 71.0 flight hours lifting 32 passengers but no cargo. VMO-6 escorted 7 med evac missions and expended 105 rockets and 3150 rounds of 7.62mm in support of 3rd Marine units. VMO-6 operations were not affected by weather, ground attack, etc.

2. Specific Operations. 030610 H to 031620 H. VMO-6 flew 45 sorties, 22.2 flight hours lifting 16 passengers but no cargo. Seaworthy expended 43 rockets and 2100 rounds of 7.62mm in support of Operation GREEN AND IV.

At 1835H on 3 November, Seaworthy 4-12 & 4-13 made an emergency extract of Crystal Star in the 0945 grid with CattleCall 5-19 & 5-20 and delivered covering fire for CattleCall during the extraction. Seaworthy 4-12 & 4-13 also delivered ordnance on suspected enemy campsites while running Mission 202. 4 November: Seaworthy 4-1 & 4-2 inserted Constitution at the 190380 and used Hellborne 555 for zone prep. Seaworthy 4-1 also inserted Parasol in the 190390 using Hellborne 556 for zone prep, and Chesterbrook in the 180420 using Gunfighter 3 & 4 for zone prep. Seaworthy 4-1 controlled the fixed wing strikes. Seaworthy 2-0 located a lost recon team north of Con Thien then covered troop lift for IceBoat. Seaworthy 4-5, 4-6 launched to run troop lift for Hasty Foot.

(continued) Seaworthy 4-5 proceeded to the 9835 to prep zone for lift using RingNeck 510 and Hellborne 511, CattleCall 5-5 through 5-8 then lifted the troops with Seaworthy 4-5, 4-6 providing cover. Seaworthy 4-9, 4-10 made zone prep and provided cover on an insert of Cosmic Wave at the 1143 grid. Seaworthy 2-8 spotted for A6A Beacon Drop (Test) for Hallmark 14, ran Hellborne 211 against enemy bunkers in the 060640 grid.
