Seaworthy 99-7, a flight of two UH-1E guns, ran Mission 401 and supported all regiments of the division with helicopter gun support on troop lifts. Seaworthy 99-9 flight, the night med evac escort gun section, escorted Dust-Off on emergency med evac in support of the US Army. The section suppressed fire from enemy automatic weapons to accomplish the emergency med evac.
