While working in poor weather at LZ Sierra, Calllocall 92-5 was downed by enemy fire. Recovery of the crew was organized by 99-3, Captain J. B. Miro, and artillery fire was under the control of Seaworthy 97-5, Major L. J. Drayor. To conduct the emergency extract of the crew and the emergency med evac, 97-5 called artillery to lay a smoke screen, and controlled 99-3 & 4 on the enemy position.
