1. Daily Operational Totals. VMO-6 flew 120 sorties, 110.1 flight hours lifting 0 passengers but no cargo. VMO-6 escorted 3 med evac missions and expended 256 rockets and 12,000 rounds of 7.62 mm in support of 3rd MarDiv units. VMO-6 operations were not affected by weather, ground attack, etc.

2. Specific Operations. 160705 H to 161850 H. VMO-6 flew 24 sorties, 21.7 flight hours lifting 0 passengers but no cargo. Seaworthy expended 105 rockets and 4,900 rounds of 7.62mm in support of Operation MAUI CRAIG.

6. Operational Highlight.

Seaworthy 98-0, while on routine VR for 7-Up, uncovered a manned .50CAL position. He controlled Arty and F/N destroying the weapon and received 1 KBA. Further recon of the area during the day revealed two more active positions. Again F/N, under control of SN 98-0 and SN 98-8 quieted the guns. SN 97-3 uncovered a small base camp, and he successfully controlled LB 226 destroying the camp and finding 5 KBA's with 10 more possibles. The Temple Lake area was fairly quiet, but SN 98-12 controlled a flight of Hell Borno 368 hitting a storage area getting a very large secondary. SN 99 aircraft flew escort and cover on various support missions. SN 99-1 & 99-2 worked recon inserts and extracts throughout the day.

SW 98-3 uncovered a .50CAL position, but was unable to destroy it because he was covering a medovac. SW 99-1 & 2 received intense fire while trying to insert Hungrain. The insert was delayed and fixed wing were called in to deliver ordnance on the enemy position. The position was destroyed. Other flights of recon were conducted by 97 and 98 aircraft throughout the day with some sightings.

1. Daily Operational Totals. VMO-6 flew 116 sorties, 75.2 flight hours lifting 0 passengers but no cargo. VMO-6 escorted 1 medevac missions and expended 231 rockets and 9,700 rounds of 7.62mm in support of 3rd MAR DIV units. VMO-6 operations were not affected by weather, ground attack, etc.

6. Operational Highlight:

Seaworthy 98-0 uncovered NVA in the old Dewey Canyon area. SN 98-7 came to support 98-0 and 98-7 lost an engine by ground fire. 98-7 successfully returned to Quang Tri, and the hot area was noted for further reference. F/W could not be run on the target because of weather and availability. SN 99-1 & 2 received heavy small arms fire while trying to insert Consitution and Isabel. SN 98-4 supported 99-1 & 2 with his ordnance and passed the target to 98-11 who ran F/W on the target area. Also it was necessary to extract Wisdom Jacket because they had a POW. This was again accomplished by SN 99-1 & 2 and 98-4. SN 97-8 assisted also in the emergency extraction. Other operations were somewhat limited because of weather in the entire operating area.

6. Operational Highlight:

Seaworthy 99-13 & 14 launched to C-4 with SW 98 flare-ships and Cattlecall Medevac. Cattlecall extracted 23 medevacs under the flares of SW 98-18 and the suppressive fire of SW 99-13 & 14. Recon inserts and extracts were conducted by SW 99-1 & 2. They had limited success because of an station CAP F/W not being available when it was needed. They had to extract Beware immediately after insertion because of Army Arty not being coordinated and it was hitting near the team and the aircraft position. SW 98-19, 98-13, and 97-11 teamed up running F/W in the Temple Lake area. They were successful in destroying concealed supply cache, getting 6 secondary explosions. There was only limited activity throughout the TAOR today, and most of the day was devoted to routine escort of resupply and VR's of the entire area.

Most of the other missions by Seaworthy ~~xxxxxx~~ aircraft were centered along Rt #9 and the Eastern part of Dong Ha Mts. There were active mortars and automatic weapons in this area and SW 97 and SW 98 worked together neutralizing the area. SW 98 aircraft ordnance was used in fire suppression and 10 flights of F/W with mixed ordnance. SW 97-7 and SW 98-7 were most instrumental in the quick actions which keep the the convoy route from more serious damage.
