1. Daily Operational Totals. WMO-6 flew 116 sorties, 117.0 flight hours lifting 0 passengers but no cargo. WMO-6 escorted 21 medevac missions and expended 246 rockets and 2,800 rounds of 7.62mm in support of 3rd MAR DIV units. WMO-6 operations were not affected by weather, ground attack, etc.

6. Operational Highlight:

Recon was started late again because the recon guns were needed for medevacs until 0930. Then one of the Army aircraft went down until 1200. Therefore, it was in the afternoon before recon was started. 14 inserts were scheduled and 8 completed. The sixth Constitution was put in the LZ then because of fire to the second aircraft became an emergency extraction. The recon package again waited over 1/2 hour for F/W and on the emergency extraction none were available because DASC diverted them. The emergency extraction was completed under the covering fire of SW 98-5. Other activity was again centered around the Dong Ha Bts. and route # 9, where an active mortar position was destroyed by OV-10A aircraft and then followed up with F/W. SW 98-8 destroyed one hooch and received 2 KBA's as well as controlling the F/W on the mortars. SW 97-9 controlled Hellborne 263 on a second active mortar position and destroyed it. The prebriefed trooplift was conducted without incident by SW 99-3 & 4 with 98-2 preping the LZ.

6. Operational Highlight: Recon was very successful today. Ten inserts were scheduled and eight were completed. There were five extracts scheduled and four were completed. There was also one emergency extraction of Saloon Keeper conducted by SW 99-7 & 8 and Cattle Call 3 & 4. Covering air was Love Bug 286, controlled by SW 98-17. All the inserts and extracts would have been completed except that one was shot out of the LZ and the others were late scheduled additions that would have taken flight crews over 6 hours. Other activity was centered around the troop lift to LZ Junior and LZ Squirrel. Both LZ's were hot and aircraft were damaged and crew members injured. Seaworthy aircraft were used for fire suppression and air controlling for the downed aircraft. SW 97-7 and 97-0 flew active VJ missions over the DEZ and all other aircraft were involved in routine missions.
