I. Narrative Summary of significant events:

MACS-7 and Detachment Alpha Controllers conducted 1036 flight followings, 88 GCI/GCA handoffs, and identified and reported 1263 friendly tracks during April 1966. Throughout the month of April the Air Defense System of Chu Lai was exercised by MACS-7 Controllers controlling 72 faked runs for HAWK (2nd LAAMBn.) engagement. MAG-12 aircraft were used in making the runs. During the past month there were 35 practice ground controlled intercepts conducted utilizing MAG-11 and MAG-12 aircraft.


On 3 April MACS-7 conducted an anti-air-warfare exercise with the 2nd LAAMBn. There were ten practice raids, again using MAG-11 and MAG-12 aircraft. All were successfully engaged by HAWK Missiles. Nine practice ground controlled intercepts were also successful.

Prior to 5 April the Radar Set AN/TPS-22A recorded 11 hours of radiating time which was utilized by Tactical Air Operations Center personnel for control. A pedestal failure placed the radar set in an inoperable status. The repair part arrived 25 April, however, the set remained inoperable because of a shortage of other parts. The Radar Set AN/TPS-34A is also inoperable awaiting parts.

On 12 April the Wing Air Control Officer arrived and conducted an Administrative and Material Inspection in the operations and training section. A grade of excellent was given to that section.

Throughout the month MACS-7 has augmented Marine Air Support Squadron-2 and is in the process of cross-training personnel at the Air Force Control and Reporting Center situated at Monkey Mountain. At the present time there are two officers TAD to MASS-2 and two officers and two enlisted men TAD to the Control and Reporting Center. On 15 April, MACS-7's TACOC was visited by a group from the Control and Reporting Center "PANAMA" to familiarize themselves with our operations.

HQMC G-4 furnished information that three (3) additional PU-608 Generators will be supplied to MACS-7. A critical need will be alleviated upon arrival of these generators. No ETA from MCSC, Barstow is available.


The camp construction program continues to improve the squadron area. Two more strong back tents have been rehabilitated with six foot side walls vice five foot side walls and metal roofing has been added. The main road through the area and the ground in front of the Administration Building has been covered with gravel. The Administration Building is also partially painted. The concrete foundation for the squadron galley and storage room was completed and the mess hall foundation was started. Two sites have been cleared and leveled for establishment of the SNCO Club and the Enlisted Club. Construction of the SNCO/Sgt club began on 22 April 1966.

Work began within the butler building on the radio maintenance shop, storage area, and offices for radio maintenance and the Communications/Electronics Officer. A 20' X 20' pad was completed to serve as the deck for a maintenance float shelter for the AN/TPS-22 radar.

The squadron's defensive perimeter has been improved by the construction of trenches between the positions, clearing and smoothing land between defensive wire and positions, improvement of existing bunkers, and construction of one new bunker covering a major avenue of approach.

In civil affairs, MACS-7 Corpsman gave minor medical treatment to 98 Vietnamese civilians. Most of these villagers were from the hamlets of Trung Toan and Xuan Troan. Forty (40) bars of soap were also handed out in the village of Xuan Troan.
