NARRATIVE SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT HIGHLIGHTS

1. (S) During the month of January 1970, MAG #11 Squadron's flew a combined total of 1621 sorties logging 2560.8 hours and expending 4631.1 tons of ordnance.
2. (U) On 2 January 1970, LtCol. S. P. LEWIS assumed command of VMA(AW)-242 when he received the squadron's colors from LtCol. T. L. GRIFFIN in a ceremony held in the squadron's hangar.
3. (S) On 5 January 1970, an F4B of VMFA-542 flown by Major L. W. ROBINSON and 1/Lt. R. W. BURNS received a direct hit while attacking a 37mm Gun position in the Steel Tiger area of operation. Almost simultaneously with the release of their ordnance, which fell on target, an airburst was observed in the vicinity of the left intake between the two cockpits. The aircraft rolled into a 45° right bank and maintained a descending turn until impact. Both crewmembers were killed in action.
4. (U) On 12 January 1970, LtCol. J. J. METZKO assumed command of VMA(AW)-225 when he received the squadron's Colors from Major P. M. BUSCH in a ceremony in the squadron's hangar.
5. (U) On 17 January 1970, WH16 landed at Danang, completing VMFA-542's last combat mission in the Republic of Vietnam. The mission, an A6A escort in the Commando Bolt area, was flown by LtCol. K. A. SMITH and 1/Lt. R. BLAIR, RIO. VMFA-542 has been involved in continuous combat operations in the Republic of Vietnam since May 1968, and originally arrived in-country in July 1965.
6. (U) On 30 January 1970, ten F4B's took off on the first leg of VMFA-542's transoceanic re-deployment to MCAS, El Toro, Calif. The remainder of VMFA-542's aircraft departed on the 31st.

INTELLIGENCE CHRONOLOGY1. SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITIES

a. Five orientation briefs for newly arrived aircrew members were conducted during the month. These briefs included information on; SAR, SERE, Survival tips, Lessons Learned, Intelligence Briefing Procedures and information on the current situation.

b. During the month the S-2 Staff Liaison Visits to ACofS G-2, FMAW.

2. OPERATIONAL INTELLIGENCE

a. During the month of January the Intelligence Section prepared maps and mission briefs for 559 Steel Tiger missions and 593 In Country missions. Mission planning included map preparation, enemy situation, target description, search and rescue procedures, anti-aircraft, ELINT and SAM Order of Battle. The scope of this planning was expanded by the continuing commitment of MAC-11 aircraft.

b. A total of 1152 missions were debriefed in addition to numerous "Hot Pad" scrambles and test hops. A large number of these missions were in direct support of the following operations: Victory Dragon XIX, Frederick Hill, Iron Mountain, Nantucket Beach, Randolph Glen, and Green River.

c. Reported significant BDA in air operations against Communist Forces in Viet Nam during the month of January are as follows:

- (1) 20 STRUCTURES OF VARIOUS CONSTRUCTION DESTROYED
- (2) 4 STRUCTURES OF VARIOUS CONSTRUCTION DAMAGED
- (3) 60 BUNKERS OF VARIOUS CONSTRUCTION DESTROYED
- (4) 120 SECONDARY EXPLOSIONS
- (5) 4 KILLED BY MARINE AIR
- (6) 14 SUSTAINED FIRES
- (7) 5 PIPE LINES CUT (POL)
- (8) 1 PUMPING STATION DESTROYED (POL)
- (9) 17 GUNS SILENCED (2PU/23/37MM)
- (10) 71 SECONDARY FIRES

d. The Intelligence Section continued to brief the Commanding Officer, Group Staff Officers and Squadron Commanders on a daily basis.

e. The Intelligence Section continues to compile the G-2 Brief Summary on a daily basis.

 - h. Attended VMA 242 change of command ceremony.
 - i. Arranged for three men to attend Bible Conference in Bagiuo, Philippines.
 - j. Made regular visits and calls to various working areas in the group.
 - k. Attended the "Many Missions Dinner" and gave invocation.
4. Civil Affairs
 - a. Donated \$100.00 in piasters to Vinh-Minh Elementary School for desks and benches.
 - b. Gave 10 pounds of candy to principal of Vinh-Minh School to distribute at TET.
 - c. Gave 100 pounds of clothes to Tin Lanh Church for the needy.
 - d. Gave nine dozen bottles of cough syrup, plus ten pounds of clothes, and some toys to the China Beach Orphanage.

Subj: Command Chronology, Month of January 1970

1. January saw an end to the MAG-11 Chicken Project. The project was a total failure for a variety of reasons. From the beginning the project was headed toward disaster. The end saw an 85% loss of the chickens. Ten of the remaining chickens were given to the family who allowed us to use their land to build the chicken coup. The rest of the chickens were given to another Civil Affairs Team. The chicken coup was broken down and discarded. A complete report has been given to the MACV Advisors so that they can prevent similiar failures in other areas.
2. Although the chicken project was a failure an interest by a few individuals has been shown. Plans are under way for a new chicken project. Presently we are building feeders and waterers. This time through the knowledge gained from the last projects mistakes and with the proper preparation the project will be a success.
3. In January repairs were completed on the southern most road in Lo Giang. However, after completion RVN trucks drove on the road prematurely and damaged it with large ruts. Even so the road condition is far better than it was prior to the work MAG-11 Civil Affairs did on it. Civil Affairs is still planning on working on the northern road. Because of the need for the equipment elsewhere we have been unable to work on it this month.
4. Ten Five Month Scholarships were given to students from Liep Lac and Co Man this month. The Headmasters of the applicants' schools were visited to establish which students had the best grades and were the most industrious. Then the students names were presented to the Hamlet Chiefs to find which were most in need and most deserving of the scholarships. An interview with the students was not held. It has been found in the past that because of the language barrier little was gained from this. A meeting was held. Each student with at least one parent came and the monthly scholarship funds were distributed by the Hamlet Chiefs.

5. During this month a couple of days were set aside to tour areas of operation controlled by other Civil Affairs Units in the Da Nang Area. The various projects visited will and have definitely helped the Civil Affairs Officer formulate ideas for the months to come.
6. Personal Response Posters have been placed on bulletin boards throughout the living and squadron areas. Personal Response Classes were held twice this month for one hundred eight incoming marines. It is felt that Personal Response is a very important function of Civil Affairs. Plans for expansion of the program are being formulated to present for approval.
7. Psyops material is being distributed on a weekly basis. It mostly consists of Ban Tin Newspapers and other informative type material. Some of this material is given to the Hamlet Chiefs to distribute, some to the Popular Forces to distribute, and the Civil Affairs Team distributes the rest. People have been observed reading this material days after it has been distributed so it appears to be a successful program.
8. The Med-Caps in Hoa Da were held twice this month in the Hamlet of Lien Lac. It was quite successful in that over 300 people were treated. Two cases were serious enough that the patient was evacuated to MAG-11 Hospital for treatment.
