PART IINARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of April 1970, Marine Aircraft Group 11 continued its combat operations against the insurgent Communist Forces within the Republic of Vietnam as a part of the First Marine Aircraft Wing and III Marine Amphibious Force. There were 2046 missions flown by MAG-11 in this 30 day period, and many of these missions were flown in support of the following operations: Victory Dragon XIX, Geneva Park, Frederick Hill, Iron Mountain, Nantucket Beach, Randolph Glen, and Green River.

On 17 April 1970, VMCJ-1 acquired the distinction of having the longest consecutive time in country, as a Marine Tactical Squadron. Also in mid-April, LtCol B. W. FARLEY relinquished command of VMCJ-1 to LtCol P. A. MANNING.

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MAG-11 also had two other changes of command in April. LtCol R. F. HEBERT relinquished command of H&MS-11 to LtCol S. F. SHEA and LtCol P. A. MANNING relinquished command of MABS-11 to Major D. F. CROWE.

MAG-11's two A-6A squadrons, VMA(AW)-242 and VMA(AW)-225, increased their combined scheduled sorties from 24 to 28 sorties per day during the month of April.

a. Five orientation briefs for newly arrived aircrew members were conducted during the month. These briefs included information on; SAR, SERE, Survival Tips, Lessons Learned, Intelligence Briefing Procedures and information on the current situation.

b. Two briefs for Aviation/Ground Officers cross orientation program attended by First Marine Division Officers were held during the month of April.

c. A representative from Group S-2 and a BN from VMA(AW)-225 made a liaison visit to the USS Ranger to discuss RSP procedures and MIBAN of new sensor targets.

2. OPERATIONAL INTELLIGENCE

a. During the month of April the Intelligence Section prepared maps and mission briefs for 391 Steel Tiger missions and 680 In-Country missions. Mission planning included map preparation.

b. A total of 1071 missions were debriefed during this period. A large number of these missions were in direct support of the following operations: Victory Dragon XIX, Geneva Park, Frederick Hill, Iron Mountain, Wantuckee Beach, Randolph Glen, and Green River.

c. Reported significant EDA in air operations against Communist Forces in Viet Nam during the month of April are as follows:

- (1) 56 TRUCKS DAMAGED OR DESTROYED
- (2) 160 SECONDARY EXPLOSIONS OR FIRES
- (3) 87 BUNKERS/STRUCTURES DESTROYED OR DAMAGED

d. The Intelligence Section continued to brief the Commanding Officer, Group Staff Officers and Squadron Commanders on a daily basis.

e. The Intelligence Section continues to compile the G-2 Brief Summary on a daily basis, and provide Intelligence lectures to newly arrived enlisted men.

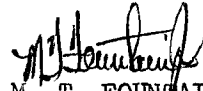

- b. In addition, numerous check-ins were interviewed and innumerable discussions held in visits to working and living spaces of the squadrons.

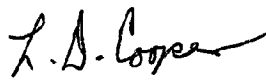

Subj: Command Chronology for the Month of April

1. April in Hoa Da village was not a good month as far as strengthening relationships with the villagers. On eighteen April Hoa Vang gave a clearance to 2nd Battalion 1st Marines 105 Battery to fire an H+I mission into Hoa Da. Twelve rounds hit on or in the vicinity of the new school in Lo Grang. The school was about 20% destroyed. Several rounds landed close to nearby homes and a baby was killed by the fragmentation. A solatium payment was made to the family. Work was begun immediately in procuring materials to repair the damage to the school. This has been quite a job as the materials seem to be extremely scarce. Presently, 10 bags of cement are needed. A meeting with the village chairman has been arranged to discuss the assignment of a work force. Once laborers have been assigned the materials will be brought out as needed.

2. Coordination with the Air Force Civil Affairs team, which operates in the northern two hamlets of Hoa Da, left a lot to be desired in April. During the past month a great deal of building materials was given to residents of these two hamlets for the repair of their homes. Shortly after this was done MAG-11 Civil Affairs received 60 requests for home improvement materials from the villagers in their area. These requests cannot possibly be approved. The action of the Air Force is detrimental to the effectiveness of MAG-11 Civil Affairs in that we cannot compete with these gifts. Worse, however, is the fact the village unity is weakened. To the villagers it appears as if the village leaders are steering the best into a couple of selected hamlets while the other hamlets go without.

3. The status of the chicken project has not changed from that reported last month. The construction of the camps has been completed and all that is awaited is the arrival of the chickens. No estimate of when this will be made as they are two months over due now.

4. Two Medcaps were canceled this past month. One was canceled because it fell in a period of high threat. The other because it fell on a Vietnamese holiday and interpreters were unavailable. The two that were held were in Co Man and Lo Grang. About 290 people were treated.

5. Personal Response Lectures and tours were given twice this month for 61 incoming marines. Attendance dropped sharply this month. A letter reminding the training officer, to insure their new personnel attend these lectures has been sent out.

6. Da Nang tours were held twice this month for 55 marines. The tour on 18 April was given with the assistance of Reverend Do a Vietnamese minister. The tour started in the Awk San school in Hoa Khanh. Watermelon and cookies were served by the vietnamese. While everyone was eating Reverend Do talked about some of the different programs the Vietnamese had initiated to help improve the conditions of less fortunate vietnamese. After the lecture a tour of the temples and the Cham Museum was conducted and also some of the projects mention in Reverend Do's lecture. The response to the tour was excellent and it is hoped that similar tours can be given in the future.

7. MAG-11 gave 10 truck loads of lumber and tin to the Christian Youth Social Service. The materials would have been discarded or burned if Civil Affairs had not taken it. Now the wood is being used for a variety of different programs. Some of it is going to Refugees in need of new homes. Some is being used in the construction of new schools. Workin through the Christian Youth Social Service has definite advantages. Because the different projects are run by Vietnamese it is more likely the materials supplied will end up where they are intended to go. They are better able to see where the need is the greatest also.

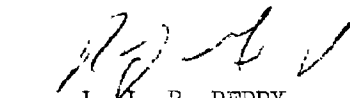
