PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of May 1970, Marine Aircraft Group 11 continued its Combat operations against the insurgent Communist forces within the Republic of Vietnam as a part of the 1st Marine Aircraft Wing and III Marine Amphibious Force. MAG-11 Squadrons flew a combined total of 2,323 sorties logging 3,841.3 hours and expending 4,634.7 tons of ordnance in support of the following operations: Geneva Park, Fredrick Hill, Iron Mountain, Nantucket Beach, Green River, Texas Star and Barber Glate.

During the month of May 1970, VMGJ-1 exceeded all previous records that were set since the Squadron first began operations in RVN in April 1965. New records were set in both Photo and electronic warfare operations and targets completed.



SECRETINTELLIGENCE (REF ID: A66414)1. SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITIES

a. Four orientation briefs for newly arrived aircrew members were conducted during the month. These briefs included information on; SAR, Survival Tips, Lessons Learned, Intelligence Briefing, Procedures and information on the current situation.

b. Two briefs for Aviation/Ground Officer Cross-Orientation program attended by 1st Marine Division officers were held during the month of May.

c. The Intelligence Officer attended a MJJI brief at XXIV Corps Headquarters.

d. Two representatives from Group S-2 made a liaison visit to the 1st Ranger for the purpose of initiating a Radar Scope Photography folder system.

e. A representative from Group S-2 accompanied a MAG-11 briefing team to MAG-13 for the purpose of briefing the MAG-13 Headquarters on Commando Bolt operations and the support procedures utilized by this command.

2. OPERATIONAL INTELLIGENCE

a. During the month of May the Intelligence Section prepared maps and mission briefs for 375 Steel Tiger missions and 741 In-Country missions. Mission planning included map preparation, Radar Scope Photography, and offset Bombing information.

b. A total of 1116 missions were debriefed during this period. A large number of these missions were in direct support of the following operations: Geneva Park, Frederick Hill, Iron Mountain, Nantucket Beach, Green River, Texas Star and Barber Gate.

c. Reported significant BDA in air operations against Communist Forces in Viet Nam during the month of May are as follows:

- (1) 78 TRUCKS DAMAGED OR DESTROYED
- (2) 224 SECONDARY EXPLOSIONS OR FIRES
- (3) 137 BUNKERS/STRUCTURES DESTROYED OR DAMAGED

d. The Intelligence Section continued to brief the Commanding Officer, Group Staff Officers and Squadron Commanders on a daily basis.

e. The Intelligence Section continues to compile the G-2 Brief Summary on a daily basis, and provide Intelligence lectures to newly-arrived enlisted men.



- a. Visited the Dispensary, Dental Clinic and the working areas regularly.
- b. Attended one MABS-11 AQM.
- c. Attended daily Ringneck Briefings.
- d. Attended Wing Chaplain Conferences and functions.

4. Civil Affairs

- a. Arranged one truckload of fruit and vegetables each to be taken to China Beach Orphanage and Sacred Heart Orphanage.
- b. Visited China Beach Orphanage twice.
- c. Delivered 45 pounds of new clothing and stuffed toys and \$200.00 (in Piasters) to China Beach Orphanage. The money was provided by the Robert Burns Memorial Fund.
- d. Had lunch with local "World Vision" representatives and Captain KHI of the ARVN.
- e. Contributed \$50.00 to the ARVN Chaplain's Memorial Fund through MACV.
- f. Attended the dedication of the Intensive Care Unit of the ARVN Hospital; visited the hospital on another occasion.

- g. Hosted the Director of Christian Youth Social Service and the "Hosanna Choir" sponsored by that organization at a regular Sunday Worship Service.
- h. 17 Marines completed at mid-month a semester of teaching English in the evenings at Anh Sang High School. Approximately 150 students were enrolled and classes were held Monday, Wednesday and Friday evenings.

Subj: Command Chronology for the Month of May

1. Hoa Da village took some large steps in the Village Self Development Program in the month of May. Four Japanese hand tractors were purchased by the village. One was purchased for Trung Lam, one for Lo Giang, and two for Con Dau. The tractors were purchased from the private funds of the villagers and are loaned out on the cooperative basis. Also a 2,500,000 VN\$ road repair program is well under way. The program was initiated by the RD Cadre and has been greatly needed in the village for some time. The road construction falls under the Village Self Development Program and is entirely sponsored by the GVN. Throughout the village there is presently a great deal of private construction going on also. Homes are being rebuilt, old shrines and temples are being repaired. This activity indicates a much more positive attitude toward the war effort.

2. In May, Civil Affairs lost its interpreter for ten days while he was on leave to Saigon. Without an interpreter Civil Affairs effectiveness is cut more than 50%. The daily work can be carried on with no problem. Any new developments or ideas are almost impossible to convey without an interpreter.

3. On 13 May, MAG-11 Civil Affairs received 190 chickens. 94 chickens were placed in one coop in northern Lo Giang and 96 in another coop in southern Lo Giang. The project has taken considerably more time than was at first anticipated. So far a successful project is in the making. Since 13 May only two chickens have been lost. One died of unknown causes and the other of a contagious disease called coccidiosis. Because preventive medicine was applied in time no other deaths have occurred. One of the main reasons the project has thus far been a success has been the tremendous cooperation received from the Vietnamese farmers involved in the project. The project is not without many obstacles however. The coops were designed for broilers. The chickens MAG-11 Civil Affairs received are layers. This will require another coop suited for birds of this type. There is a lack of experts on animal husbandry which makes positive analysis of diseases impossible. Once a disease is analyzed, medicine for the cure is expensive or unavailable. Feeding the birds has been mostly guess work. Data on types of mash being used is non-existent. Attempts are being made by Civil Affairs to remedy some of these problems but it will be a long time before something of any size or stability will be established.

4. The work on the school in Lo Giang that was hit by artillery commenced this month. The materials supplied have all been used in the reconstruction of the building. Most of the heavy construction has been completed and all that is left is some minor finish work.

5. MedCAPs were held once in Lo Giang hamlet, Co Man hamlet, and Liem Lac hamlet. About 350 patients were treated. Lo Giang hamlet has proven the success of the MedCAP program. MedCAPs have been going into this hamlet for over a year. Over the year fewer and fewer people would come for treatment. Lately only 25 to 30 people have been showing up. The doctors report that even these people have mostly minor injuries and illnesses. From the doctors' observations the villagers are treating themselves and taking care to keep their wounds clean. They are applying the methods of first aid learned from the MedCAPs. A new site for the Lo Giang MedCAP will be discussed with the village chief in the near future. A fourth MedCAP was scheduled to go to Liem Lac. The MedCAP is situated in a small meeting house. It is necessary to cross a river and walk in about 500 meters to get to the building. Upon arrival at the river's edge the local people refused to take the MedCAP across on the claim that VC were in the area. Whether this was done out of concern for their own safety or ours is not known. This type information and, in this case, non-assistance is highly appreciated. The MedCAP was cancelled for that day.

6. Personal Response School was held twice this month for 86 incoming Marines.

7. A DaNang city tour was held once in this past month for 20 interested Marines.
