1. Normal support for the units of MAG-11 continues during this period. Embarkation Assistance was rendered to VAO-2 in its redeployment. Some assistance was given to Wing Headquarters in its stand down in preparation for redeployment.

- 4, 5, 6 April 1971 Provided and operated forklifts at deep water pier for embarkation of VAO-2. Utilities provided working parties for the embarkation of VAO-2. Motor Transport provided and operated tractor and trailers to move VAO-2 to deep water pier for embarkation.
- 9 April 1971 Utilities removed all plumbing in hutch behind NCO club, replaced circuit breaker in Recovery hut, replaced broken lights and receptacles in VAO-2 living area, and changed 220v line to 110v at Material. Security built bunkers in A area. Motor transport provided one (1) tractor in support of MWFG-1.
