## PART II

### NARRATIVE SUMMARY

- 1. During June the MAG-12 Civic Action Team continued supporting local schools through construction of benches, desks and planning requirements for the coming school year. MedCap teams treated 627 Vietnamese during June.
- 2. During the month of June the following Group Staff Sections moved from SEASIA Buildings into one large Butler building: CO, XO, ADJ, SGT MAJOR, S-1, and S-4.
