1. Marine Air Base Squadron-13 continued its support of Marine Aircraft-13 and the Air Base at Chu Lai, NVA

- 1. Fersonnel. 26 enlisted and three officers were joined while 27 enlisted and three officers were transferred.
- 2. Administration. There was on officer and 23 enlisted promoted during this period.
- 3. Awards. Two purple hearts and three medals were awarded during this period.
- 4. Casualties. None

- 5. Morale. Contracts were completed to build a tennis court, remodel the basketball court and handball court.
- 6. <u>Informational Services</u>. 39 Fleet Home Team News Heleases were submitted during this period.
- 7. TAFDS. A total of 3,692,148 gallons of JP-4 fuel were received, 3,501,029 gellons of JP-4 fuel issued, and a total of 2,027 aircraft refuled.
- 8. Communications. A total of 16,674 messages were handled in the MAG-13 Communication Center. Installation has begun on the new dial telaphone systems.
- 9. Motor Transport. A total of 61,878 miles were traveled during this period. 2,159 tons of cargo was hauled. A total of 44 vehicles are presently deadlined.
- 10. Air Operations. Total amount of armestments is now 22,823. A total of 40 washdowns were performed.
- 11. Ground Defense. The Alert Platoon and the CLLC platoon muster nightly. 11 new bunkers are in the process of being constructed.
- 12. Base Services. The utilities section completed 50 work request. The laindry washed approximately 35,000 pounds of clothing. The water point supplies 2,250,000 gallons of water for the MAG-13 cantonment.
