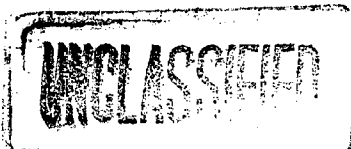

1. Marine Air Base Squadron-13 continued its support of Marine Aircraft Group-13 and the Air Base at Chu Lai, RVN.

PART THREE: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. Personnel. 75 enlisted and three officers were joined while 57 enlisted and two officers were transferred.

2. Administration. There were thirty one enlisted promoted during this period.

3. Awards. One Meritorious Mast.

5. Morale. Remains high.

6. Informational Services. 197 Fleet Home Town News Releases were submitted during this period.

7. TAFDS. A total of 4,792,361 gallons of JP-4 fuel were received, 4,800,064 gallons of JP-4 fuel issued, and a total of 2,427 aircraft refueled.

8. Motor Transport. A total of 61,379 miles were traveled during this period. 4,360 tons of cargo was hauled. A total of 33 vehicles are presently deadlined.

9. Air Operation. Total amount of arrestments is now 23,904. A total of 50 washdowns were performed.

10. Ground Defense. The Alert Platoon and the CIBD Platoon muster nightly.

11. Base Services. The utilities section completed over 60 work requests. The laundry washed approximately 35,000 pounds of clothing. The water point supplied 2,250,000 gallons of water for the MAG-13 Cantonment.
