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## PART TWO - Narrative Summary

(U) Marine Wing Support Group 17 continued to perform its assigned missions and tasks in support of the First Marine Aircraft Wing at the Da Nang Air Base in the Republic of Vietnam. During this period the Group also continued to develop its new camp facilities. This included completion of the NCO billet area and the renovation of the enlisted area. The Group Post Office was also opened during this period. The defensive posture of this Group was improved as a result of modifications of the perimeter bunkers, additional use of lights, and the installation of additional concertina wire. A review of the Proposed Table of Organization was completed and is included as part four of this report.

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## PART THREE - Significant Events

1. Personnel. (C) WERS-17 remained in a C-2 status throughout the period. H&MS-17 attained a C-2 status as a result of an increase of 79 personnel assigned.
2. Administration. (U) Routine administration prevailed during this period.
3. Awards. (U) The following awards were delivered:

8 men were awarded permanent Combat Air Crewman insignia and 30 men were awarded Temporary Combat Air Crewman insignia.

4. Casualties. (U) There were no hostile casualties during this period. There were 8 admissions, 6 returned to duty and two evacuation from country.

5. Civic Action. (U) For the major part of December MWSG-17 continued its civil affairs projects previously established to the North, West and Northeast of Danang Air Base in the local area.

Three hundred and seventy-five Vietnamese were given medical treatment in the MWSG-17 MEDCAP program, including ten receiving dental treatment, at XUAN HOA, north of the Air Base.

Two hundred gallons of scrap food was delivered to the WEC childrens home, northeast of the Air Base in the vicinity of Phuang An Trung in support of the institutions livestock and animal husbandry program.

Twenty window frames and plastic inserts were constructed, delivered and installed at the Hoa That Buddhist school for refugee orphans, west of the Air Base. Seventy-five pounds of Christmas candy and nuts were delivered to this institution, which has over 600 children in its care.

In mid December the 1stMAW assumed civil affairs jurisdiction and responsibility for the Hoa Cuong village which takes in all of the land in the southeast boundary of the air base and the Song Han River. This village is comprised of six hamlets. The Commanding Officer, MWSG-17 proposed that his command assume civil affairs sponsorship of the Ap Bo hamlet.

To assist in organizing civil affairs in this area the following support was provided to the 1stMAW:

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Two helicopter flights were made to familiarize Civil Affairs Officers of the Marine Air, Headquarters, and Support Groups with the area, to organize the area for assignment to the groups, and to permit preliminary planning of assignment of project and hamlet sub-divisions to squadrons within the groups.

Vehicles and escort were provided for two field trips. One trip provided the VNAF-USAF Advisor a reconnaissance of the area and established the hamlet assignment for this activity. The other trip provided a liaison team from the 29th Civil Affairs Company familiarization with the area and constituted the first action in compiling a survey which will be the basis for recommending projects for Group action.

Two helicopter flights were provided to this liaison team for the purpose stated above.

In the latter part of December, the MWSG-17 Medical Section began participation in the 1stMAW MEDCAP program with a schedule of two treatment periods a week in the District Health Center, located in Hoa Cuong village. Thirty one Vietnamese were treated. Training for the District Health Technician and two nurses was commenced.

6. Morale/Welfare Programs. (U) The use of the facilities at China Beach continued to be utilized. A total of 19 personnel were sent to CONUS on special 30 day leave and 36 personnel participated in the R&R program.

7. Informational Services. (U) A total of 207 Fleet Home Town News Releases were submitted.

8. Intelligence. (U) S-2 completed the following:

a. Clearances requested:

- (1) SECRET 3
- (2) CONFIDENTIAL 4

b. Clearances Completed:

- (1) SECRET 4
- (2) CONFIDENTIAL 4

c. Briefings conducted:

- (1) Daily Conference Intelligence Briefs 31

- (3) Special Staff WCO's Intelligence Briefs 3

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9. Air Operations. (C) H&MS-17 had the following aircraft assigned at the beginning of the period: 3 C-117D, 2 US-2B, 5 UH-34D, and 1 UC-45J. One C-117D was transferred to MAG-12 on 10 December. Two UH-34D helicopters were transferred to MAG-36, one on 15 December and one on 31 December. The UC-45J was transferred to overhaul on 24 December. During the month of December, H&MS-17 aircraft transported 2,365 passengers, 43,000 pounds of baggage and mail and 426,927 pounds of cargo for a total of 331.9 flight hours in support of III MAF. Twelve flare missions were flown in support of ground forces, dispensing 671 flares. Two radio relay missions were flown. A total of 216 missions were flown as follows: C-117D 95, US-2B 71 and UH-34D 50.

One hundred and one personnel of the aircraft maintenance department attended a special two day course on the Naval Aviation Maintenance and Material Management Program. The course was conducted by personnel of the First Marine Aircraft Wing in preparation for the institution of the program on 1 January 1967.

10. Ground Defense. (U) Construction on an additional defensive bunker on the perimeter was completed bringing the sector total to four. In addition, a twenty-one foot observation tower was constructed in the center of the assigned defensive perimeter. The Reaction forces were exercised daily during the reporting period as a result of intelligence data indicating a possible enemy attack. Familiarization firing of the riot gun was accomplished for the security personnel.

11. Training. (U) Routine GMST training was conducted at the Squadron level and all incoming personnel were given informational and Orientational lectures with particular reference to in-country security, safety, personal conduct, missions and civil affairs requirements. NBC training was conducted at group and squadron level. Assigned quotas were filled to the following schools:

- a. Helicopter Aerial Gunner's School, Okinawa
- b. NCO Leadership School, Okinawa

12. Motor Transport. (U) Wing Equipment and Repair Squadron 17, operated the assigned 150 prime movers and 56 trailers a total of 66,280 miles. A total of 3,066 tons of general cargo and 2,752 tons of Class VA were transported. Vehicles awaiting disposition total 26.

13. Maintenance. (U) The 4th Echelon Repair Facility received 340 items for repair and completed 377 of which 45 were beyond economical repair. At the close of the period there were 300 open job orders on hand. Of these 5.3% were in the process of completion, 4.0% were awaiting manpower, 5.3% were awaiting space and 85.4% were parts. Although no additional structures were made available, better utilization of existing facilities significantly reduced the number of jobs awaiting work space. An increase in personnel during the period greatly reduced the number of jobs awaiting sole manpower.

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14. Engineering. (C) The Engineering Equipment Section continued to provide maximum support within its capability. Electric power was furnished to the Air Terminal area, VMGR-152 area, TAFDS site and the MWSG-17 cantonment area. The mean average of 16 generators operated 3,120 hours during the period. A total of 4 generators have been programmed for induction into the 5th Echelon repair facility. The 45 pieces of Heavy Equipment assigned, operated total of 1582 hours.

15. Logistics. (C) The TAFDS Section continued the operation of two sites, Khe Sanh and the Marine Air Terminal. The system at the Marine Air Terminal issued 1,003,745 gal of JP-4 and 57,994 gal of Av/Gas. An expeditionary pipe line was laid from the Air Force fuel point at Danang to the site at Marine Air Freight, thus making JP-4 available when Air Force demand did not exceed the supply capability. The assigned refueler trucks continue to be required and operated a total of 1,535 miles.

16. Maintenance/Engineering/Avionics. (U) The Headquarters and Maintenance Squadron of the Group continued to provide routine support in these areas.

17. Base Development/Military Construction. (U)

a. The following projects were undertaken:

a. Requested 150 cu meters of gravel and 50 cu meter sand be delivered MWSG-17 compound during period Feb-Apr-67.

b. Submitted urgent minor construction, maintenance and repair budgetary planning information in the amount of \$53,997.00 to G-5.

c. Received special funds in the amount of \$5,000.00 per quarter for purchase of utilities and building supplies from NSA DANANG.

d. Submitted project for 6 airconditioners for Medical/Dental facilities and 1 airconditioner for 4th Echelon C&I shop

e. Started construction on 2 grease traps for messhall.

f. Submitted construction criteria for priority construction of a warehouse for storage of SATS Equipment.

g. CB's finished cantonment project.

h. Started construction on shed type structure to cover mess gear washing area.

i. Started construction on SATS warehouse.

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Construction of Intermediate Maintenance Shops continued throughout December with the following results:

- a. Airframes Shop 50% capability
- b. Hydraulic Shop 75% capability
- c. Aviator Equipment 75% capability
- d. Avionics Shop 80% capability
- e. Wing Dynamic Drive 25% capability
- f. Power Plant-Rotary 50% capability

18. EOD. (U) During the month of December 1966, this section responded to a total of 119 requests for EOD support. 83 responses were of a nature that required actual EOD assistance. The other 36 required no assistance due to the ordnance involved being safe or no ordnance. The unit responded to 11 calls in the Danang TAOR, 4 off base and 7 at Marble Mountain AF. 5 calls were received to check out suspected booby trapped areas of which one was found to be actually booby trapped.

The team answered 2 calls for technical and intelligence advice for the 1 Corps Chemical Officer and provided one EOD technician to support the ground force EOD team in the Chu Lai area for a period of 3 days and one member to accompany the rough rider convoy from Danang to Phu Bai for one day.

The unit destroyed by detonation, a total of 99 pieces of ordnance and explosive material and rendered safe another 70 pieces.

On the 14th of December the unit moved from the Air Force side of the field to the Marine flight line. A total of 14 days were spent renovating and rebuilding the building and area. At present, the building and area is considered 60% complete.

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PART FOUR - Supporting Documents

A review of the Proposed M-8710 and M-8715 Tables of Organization of the Marine Support Group was conducted during this reporting period. The final review and recommendations are attached as Appendix I.

1. In response to reference (a), enclosures (1) and (2) are submitted herewith. MWSG-17 is presently organized along the concepts generated by references (b) and (c), which were received in August 1966, and which have not yet been officially approved by the Commandant of the Marine Corps.

2. Enclosures (1) and (2) follow the basic organization laid down by references (a) and (b), but there are some significant changes in the size of some sections. Justification for the recommended changes is discussed in paragraphs 3 and 4 below, for H&MS, MWSG and W&RS, MWSG respectively.

3. The recommendations for changes in the T/O for H&MS, MWSG are based on the following factors.

a. H&MS Command Section. An additional Asst Ops Officer is required due to the variety of aircraft assigned and the need to have a fully qualified pilot for each type. Additional duties for this officer will be NATOPS and flight scheduling.

b. Aircraft Maintenance Section

(1) Enclosure (1) recommends 4 additional officers and 66 additional enlisted personnel over that called for by reference (b). The organization of this section is substantially in consonance with references (d), (e) and (f). Reference (g) contains instructions for the planned implementation of reference (f) on 1 January 1967. Required personnel and additional billets for the 3M system have been

included in enclosure (1). The recommended maintenance personnel are based on organizational and intermediate level maintenance for three (3) C-117's, two (2) US2B's, one UC-45J and three (3) UH-34D aircraft, all of which are presently assigned. The personnel requirements are in conformance with MO factors contained in reference (h), allowance column, for like or similar aircraft.

(2) It must be recognized that H&MS-17 has peculiar maintenance personnel requirements due to its location and assigned additional tasks (Wing Full Pressure Suit Facility) and operational employment of assigned aircraft (ie, Flare Drops, Radio Relay, Helo Gunners). These factors were evidently not considered in the formulation of reference (b).

c. Data Processing Section. An increase in the size of this section is based on the projected requirements of implementation of the 3M system.

d. Wing/Group Marine Exchange Section. Additional personnel are required for this section due to the addition of two Marine Air Groups to the Wing and the widespread location of Wing Units in RVN.

e. Wing/Group Postal Section. Same comment as paragraph 3.d. above.

f. Base Services Section. A large increase in the Photographic Unit is called for. This unit is presently assigned to MWHG-1 and performs Wing-wide photographic support. It is recommended that this unit be assigned to MWSG-17. The Motor Transport Unit of the Base Services Section has been deleted since this support is available from WERS.

g. Communications Section. Six additional communications personnel are requested. Two 2811's will be used for maintenance of switchboards and telephones. Reference (b) does not provide for this type of maintenance. The other 4 additional communications personnel are required for maintenance of Autodin equipment and for maintaining the extensive wire communications for the wide-spread MWSG-17 operating area.

h. Security Section. The size of this section has been reduced significantly. This reduction is based on the present lack of requirement to operate a Wing Brig Unit and a reduced requirement for internal security compared to the proposed Security Section component contained in reference (b).

i. NBC Weapons Section. This section is not presently attached to MWSG-17 and has therefore been deleted from reference (b).

j. Wing/Group Supply Section. This section has undergone a major reorganization and growth due to the planned supply support of the forthcoming 3M system.

4. Enclosure (2) recommends an increase of two officers and 155 enlisted personnel over the allowances contained in reference (c). Justification for these additional personnel is shown as follows:

a. Command Section. An operations unit has been added to provide the squadron a central coordination capacity to receive commitments, schedule

workload, prepare reports, and provide general supervision and guidance for the interrelated squadron functions.

b. Motor Transport Operations Unit. Enclosure (2) recommends an increase of 93 enlisted personnel over the allowance contained in reference (c). WERS-17 is presently operating the same number of vehicles provided to the old MABS-17 prior to its disestablishment. As yet, there is no published T/E for MMSG squadrons, which must account for the sparse personnel allowance contained in reference (c). It is to the advantage of the 1st Marine Air Wing to continue to operate the present Motor Transport vehicles assigned to WERS-17 to the maximum possible utilization.

c. Engineer Equipment Section. Enclosure (2) recommends an increase of 51 enlisted personnel in this section for the same reasons expressed in paragraph 4.b. above.

d. Maintenance/Repair Section. The concept of reference (c) is for this section to provide storage, maintenance and training for SATS launch and recovery, Cryogenics and TAFDS equipment. At present WERS is also tasked with the field operation of two TAFDS systems. Therefore, 13 additional TAFDS personnel are requested. An additional 3 cryogenics personnel are requested to adequately perform the mission assigned.
