PART TWO

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

- 1. During the month of December this unit continued to provide support for the IstMAW as well as organic support of MWSG-17.
 - a. The Motor Transport Section operated the assigned prime movers a total of 68,067 miles. A total of 8,644 tons of general cargo was transported during the month. There were a total of 993 taxi runs carring 2,352 passengers for a total of 5,636 miles.
 - b. The 4th Echelon Repair Facility received 538 items for repair and completed 525 of which 135 were beyond economical repair. At the close of the period there were 177 open job orders on hand. Of these 7.93% were in the process of completion, 23.67% awaiting manpower and 68.4% awaiting parts.
 - c. The TAFDS Section continued the operation of two sites, Khe Sanh and the Danang Marine Air Freight Terminal. The Khe Sanh system issued 61,484 gallons of Jr-4 and 26,908 gallons of Av/Gas. The system at the Danang Marine Air Freight Terminal issued 1,122,231 gallons of Jr-4 and 77,484 gallons of Av/Gas. Total fuel dispensed was 1,288,105 gallons.
 - d. The Engineering Equipment Section continued to provide maximum support within its capability. Electric power was furnished to the Air Terminal area, VMGR 152 area and the TAFDS site. The MwSG-17 contonment went on French commercial electrical power (S.I.T.A.) about the middle of December. The generators now assigned operated 2876 hours. The heavy equipment assigned operated 1888 hours.
 - e. The squadron entered a C2 status on personner during this reporting period. During the month of December 8 personner joined the squadron and 33 were transferred from the squadron. A total of 21 personner went on R&R and 26 personner went on special reave.

TRAINING:

There were a total of 460 hours of GMST training during the reporting period.

ADWARDS:

The Commanding Officer presented two Good Conduct Awards during this period. The Commanding Officer presented five Meritorious Mast during this period.

Two personnel of this squadron assisted the Group Chaplain in teaching English classes to the Vietnamese at the Catholic school located in the village of Thon Phuoc Tuong for a period of three hours per week.

During the month of December five (5) taxis were used for civic action.

On 19, 21, 25, 26 and 29Dec67 6X6's were used to deliver civic action material to Red Beach and Golden Gate USO and USOM Hospital.

On 1, 4, 6, 8, 11, 12, 13, 15,16, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 26, 27, 28 and 29Dec67 taxis were used to transport personnel to and from the Baptist Mission, Danang Police Station, Catholic School and the RVN Hospital for the purpose of teaching conversational English and showing films to the Vietnamese people.
