NARRATIVE SUMMARY

- 1. Wing Equipment and Repair Squadron 17 continues to support the 1stMAW in the form of 1st through 4th echelon maintenance. Additional support is provided the Wing utilizing the rolling assets of the Motor Transport and Engineer Equipment Sections.
- 2. In addition to the normal maintenance services performed Motor Transport vehicles traveled 180,122 miles, hauled 1,525 tons of equipment, and carried 82,488 passengers during the inclusive dates.
- 3. The Engineer Equipment Section provided 1,216 Equipment hours, 416, man hours, and hauled 546,000 pounds of equipment supporting 1stMAW Units. This support included Equipment Operation, Road Testing of Equipment, Load Testing of Equipment, and after hours support such as dispatching and 2nd echelon maintenance connected with continuous operations.
- 4. Wing Equipment and Repair Squadron 17 provided 9,004 man hours and 909,225 gallons of JP-5 from TAFDS in support of MAG-12 and MAG-15 operations.

- 1. On 23 August 1972 1stSgt R. D. LASHLEY assumed duties as Squadron Sergeant Major.
- 2. TAFDS ceased refueling operations on 24 October 1972, and is now only involved in equipment maintenance.

- 4. Squadron personnel participated in a Blood Drive on 18-19 December 1972.
