

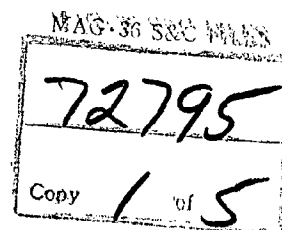

Two corroded gas generators were shipped to NARF Rhode Island for refurbishing.

(C) The maintenance section assembled and functionally tested four retrieve engines returned from overhaul. Functionally tested two absorber assemblies and two retrieve engines in preparation for shipment to Nam Phong.

(C) The service change crew completed installation of service changes 9, 23 and 58. An unserviceable catapult consol was completely renovated and made into a testing lab for fresnel lens cells and associated equipment and is now operational.

(U) On 15 September, military installations based on Okinawa went into Typhoon Condition II. All equipment and loose gear was secured.

(C) The supply section shipped the following gear to Nam Phong:

Two M-23 Packages	Absorber Assemblies
Two M-11 Packages	Retrieve Engines
Two M-24 Packages	Aprons and Stakes
Two L-13 Packages	Single Conductor Bulk Cable
